Project to replace the Newcomb Road Bridge over the Canisteo River, a Class C navigable stream, including abutments and piers. An Incidental Take Permit is required because the Department has determined that the project would result in a “take” or “taking” of state-listed freshwater mussel species or its habitat, pursuant to Environmental Conservation Law Section 11-0535 and 6 NYCRR Part 182. A Net Conservation Benefit Plan has been developed to avoid, minimize, and mitigate adverse impacts to state-listed freshwater mussels. This plan includes reducing encroachment of the stream via removal of an existing pier and relocating bridge abutments, salvage and relocation of freshwater mussels within the project area, and planting of live willow stakes along 80 linear feet of the stream bank to reduce erosion and sedimentation of the Canisteo River. Monitoring of the mussels following relocation as well as establishment of the plantings following project completion is also proposed.
