In Loving Memory of Monte Gene Burdick

Monte Gene Burdick lived life the only way he knew how: loud, stubborn, complicated and completely on his own terms. If you knew Monte, you knew he loved rock’n’ roll. There was a good chance you’d hear his guitar echoing through the house at all hours of the day or night. He loved being outdoors, looking at the stars with his children, fishing whenever he could and camping. He wasn’t a man of luxury, but he found joy in the simple things.

Monte was also an incredibly talented carpenter. He took immense pride in his work and had an eye for detail that couldn’t be taught. If anyone offered to help with the finishing touches, the answer was almost always the same: “No. I have a reputation to maintain.” He had pride in a craft he had spent years mastering. He believed that if his name was attached to something, it had to be done right and the quality of his work still stands as a testament to the skill of his hands.

Monte wasn’t perfect, and he never pretended to be. He struggled with addiction and carried burdens that often made life difficult for both himself and those around him. He could be mean, hard-headed, and impossible to reason with. But behind closed doors, there was a heart that loved deeply, even if he didn’t always know how to show it.

Growing up, though he never had much money, there were always presents under the Christmas tree, Easter baskets full of candy and homemade birthday cakes every single year for his kids. Every now and then there’d even be a handmade birthday card. Looking back, those weren’t just traditions; they were his way of saying, “I love you.”

Monte was the kind of man that would give you the shirt off his back... or fight you for the last glass of vodka. That’s just who he was: a walking contradiction and a one-of-a-kind character. He wasn’t the kind of man whose life could be summed up by saying, “He made everyone smile.”The truth is,



sometimes he made people laugh, sometimes he made them angry and sometimes he broke their hearts. But through it all, the one thing that never changed was how proud he was of his children. More than anything, he wanted them to have a better life than the one he had. Monte was preceded in death by the love of his life and partner of 25 years, Teresa Torres, whom he loved fiercely and missed every day. He is survived by his children: Monte Burdick Jr. and his wife, Christy Burdick; David Brown and his wife, Karissa Brown; Alyssa Burdick; Hannah Burdick; Lena Burdick; and Nina Burdick.

He also leaves behind the greatest legacy of all—his grandchildren: Monte III, Greggory, Abbigail, Nicholas, Collen, Jacob, James, Jade, Apollo, Estella, Raiden, and Zenith.

In the final chapter of his life, Monte found something that had long eluded him: He accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior, and that decision became one of the most meaningful parts of his journey. Monte’s story wasn’t neat, and it wasn’t easy. It was messy, real, and undeniably human. He made mistakes, he loved hard, he fought his own battles and he left behind people who will remember every side of him.

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NOTICE OF FILING OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION PLAN FOR THE CANISTEO WIND ENERGY LLC TRANSMISSION PROJECT

Case 19-T-0041 – Application of Canisteo Wind Energy LLC for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need Pursuant to Article VII of the Public Service Law

Background

On August 11, 2022, the New York State Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission) issued an *Order Adopting Joint Proposal and Granting Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, with Conditions* (Certificate Order) pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) Article VII approving the proposed transmission line and related equipment (Transmission Facility). The Transmission Facility comprises an approximately 15.3-mile, 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line to be located in the Town of Canisteo, Town of Jasper, City of Hornell, Town of Hornellsville, and the Village of Canisteo in Steuben County, New York. Canisteo Wind Energy LLC (CWE) will build and operate the Transmission Facility to connect the Collection Substation, a component of the Canisteo Wind Energy Facility proposed to be located in the Town of Jasper (Article 10 Facility) and authorized by the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (Siting Board) pursuant to PSL Article 10, to a new Point of Interconnection (POI) Switchyard to be built by CWE adjacent to the New York State Electric and Gas (NYSEG) Bennett Substation in the Town of Hornellsville. A detailed description of the planned Transmission Facility can be found on the New York State Department of Public Service (DPS) Document Matter Management (DMM) System for this Proceeding (see below).

The Commission in the *Certificate Order* identified a need for the Transmission Facility (*i.e.*, to interconnect the Article 10 Facility to the State’s transmission system), concluding that the Transmission Facility avoids or minimizes to the extent practicable the identified potential environmental impacts that could result from the construction and operation of the Transmission Facility; confirming that the Transmission Facility complies will all applicable State and local laws; and determining that the Transmission Facility will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Environmental Management and Construction Plan Filing

In accordance with the *Certificate Order*, on or about August 12, 2026, CWE will file an Environmental Management and Construction Plan (EM&CP) for installation of stabilized construction entrances (SCE) for the Transmission Facility (EM&CP Phase I – SCE). The EM&CP Phase I – SCE will describe the proposed SCE installation activities expected to take place between September 18, 2026 and December 31, 2026.

An electronic copy of the EM&CP Phase I – SCE will be available for public inspection on the Applicant’s website (<https://canisteowind.invenergy.com>) and on the DPS website (dps.ny.gov). 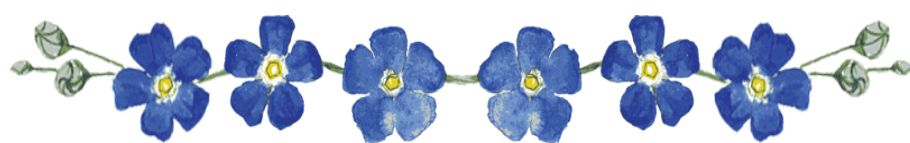
