On Wednesday, July 30, the Addison Village Board made a significant decision to begin a dissolution study, aimed at exploring the implications of disbanding the village government and merging it with the town. The board has appointed the LaBerge Group to conduct this essential analysis.

Dissolution studies serve to assess the potential effects of such a governmental shift, examining factors like cost savings, service delivery changes, and the overall impact on taxpayers and residents. The comprehensive review will also address the management of assets, liabilities, and personnel during and following the dissolution process, ensuring a thorough understanding of the consequences that could arise from this significant transition.

First, I would like to thank the residents of the Village of Addison who signed the petition for the study for dissolving the village. If you weren't asked, it was because we only needed a certain percentage of voters to sign.
Here is an update about the dissolution issue. The Village Board and Mayor asked a consultant to come and give some logistics and pros and cons of a dissolution. After that, at the next meeting, they voted on if they should have a study. They were all in agreement for this study and would contact some consultants. The Board had a special meeting to decide who would be the best consultant to contact. As I understand, they picked the Laberge Group because of the time frame.
Remember this study is to see if this dissolution would be in the best interests of the residents of Addison. So I hope you will keep an open mind.
2023 was, by far, one of the worst years I can remember. I talked to Trustee Graham about the anticipation bond of 2023 that I called a dead horse. He told me the horse might get revived. Then, we may be able to use the anticipation bond of \$250,000 on a new water project. I told him I'd like to see the village more vigilant like using the Addison Post for news rather than FaceBook.
