# Addison Senior Citizen Luncheon



Beulah Hurd passed peacefully into the loving arms of Jesus on August 27, 2025 at the home of her daughter and son-in-law in Woodhull, NY.




Eileen's life was a beautiful reflection of faith, family, and fortitude. Her memory will forever remain a blessing in the hearts of those she touched.





**Interesting Facts About The Constitution** \*Writing of the Constitution: The Constitution took Convention took place in Philadelphia from May 25 to september 17, 1787. James Madison,

often called the "Father of the Constitution", played a significant role in drafting the document. The original purpose of the convention was to revise the Articles of Confederation, but they decided to create a new Constitution instead.

\*Signing of the Constitution: On September 17, 1787, 39 of the 55 delegates present signed the final draft of the Constitution at Independence Hall.Benjamin Frandklin, at 81 years old, was the oldest delegae to sign the Constitution, while Jonathan DAyton, at 26 years old, was the youngest.

\* **Radification:** The Constitution needed to be ratified by nine states to becme effective.

The first state to ratify the Constituion was Delaware on December 7, 1787. The ninth state to ratify was New Hampshire, which occurred on June 21, 1788, making the Constitution official.
