Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

From our First Reading, Moses lifted his arms up all day in prayer, the Hebrew army, led by his successor Joshua, would conquer the enemy. If Moses would put his arms down, the army would start to get defeated. In this, the Hebrew people learned the power of intercessory prayer. Intercessory prayer happens when we take time out of our day to specifically pray for the intentions of another person or group. The widow in our Gospel showed the power of intercessory prayer as she was constant and persistent in making a request to the judge and so the judge listened intently to the widow and make his decision.

I would encourage all parishioners to identify as an intercessor. Each of us is called to pray for others. Each of us is to believe that God listens to all our prayers and that He responds more specifically and powerfully the more that our prayers are specific and persistent. Be an intercessor for the pastor his co-workers in our parish. Be an intercessor for all our parishioners to become knowledgeable of our Catholic faith and to grow in holiness. Be an intercessor for the evangelization and ministry we do. Be an intercessor for the homebound or those who are sick. Be an intercessor for our parish development. Be an intercessor for various needs of our Church, city, and world. Be in intercessor in your home, in your car, in the church, in the chapel. Be constant and specific.

For sure we need to be attentive to the fact that many of the good things Jesus is doing in our midst is blossoming forth from the countless intercessory prayers that have been prayed over the past years and decades by our own parishioners and throughout the whole area and world. Speaking of specific, we have no idea of all of the good things that are happening because of the hours spent in intercessory prayer in our Eucharistic Adoration chapel.

In Christian prayer, our first priority is to first have time where we simply allow Jesus to encounter us and to encounter Him back all in the love of the Holy Spirit. But we also need times where we are praying for others. October 7th, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, is a day that we are constantly reminded how the intercessory prayer of the Rosary helped save Europe from Islamic forces in the naval battle of Lepanto. The Catholic Church and the saints have a multitude of glory stories in terms of the power of intercessory prayer.

In the words of Saint Francis of Assisi: "Let us begin again brothers, for until now we have done nothing." Whether we are new or accustomed to intercessory prayer, now is time to take up this call for the Church and world.

Jesus, we thank you for all of the things you have done through us but today we renew our commitment to be prayer warriors for our Church and world and may this prayer help build a civilization of love throughout the world through new evangelization- new zeal, new methods, and new expressions.
