



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are called to be people of the Beatitudes. The word “beatitude” means blessed. It is not just the idea that you will be blessed later if you do these things, but it is the person who does these things now that experiences how fortunate they are to live this way and to receive the blessings now that come from following the footsteps of Jesus and his personality. Grace builds on nature.

“Poor in spirit” means that we recognize that without Jesus we do not have what it takes to get to Heaven or even to live the truth now.

Those who “mourn”- Jesus is near those who are suffering. The Cross is a symbol of His mourning with us.

“Meekness” means long and patient suffering through something. We simply keep walking to Heaven in truth and love regardless of the situation.

“Righteousness” means being made like Jesus in holiness. Happy are the people who do whatever is necessary to become full of Christ’s light.

Jesus’ love given to us is experienced as “mercy.” A forgiving love. Blessed are those who empty themselves in order to give love when others do not deserve it. It is by doing this that we are then open to receive more mercy from Jesus. The measure we measure out will be measured back to us.

The “clean of heart” are those who live Jesus’ vision of Christian marriage, which is the unique and beautiful lifelong friendship between one man and one woman until death with the purpose and openness for the union of the spouses and the procreation and education of children in every marital act. And also that sexual activity of any kind be relegated only to within Christian marriage. When Christian marriage is embraced, the world will be pure and full of splendor.

“Peacemakers”- Jesus and the Church are a reconciliation movement. Jesus prayed that we might all be one. This is to start with the parish community and then radiates out everywhere.

Blessed are those who are persecuted for personally striving or to help others be holy in Jesus’ power and love.

Blessed is the person being persecuted or talked bad about for living and sharing the Catholic worldview. The Cross leads to the Resurrection. Let’s live this experience together! Let’s be known as the parish of the beatitudes! Come Holy Spirit!
