By using your weekly envelopes or giving online it will show you are a **registered active member** of ICC. If there is no giving history for 6 months you will be marked "inactive".

If you do not currently receive envelopes please call the parish office to register or re-register.

Please be sure to take a few minutes to register. This can be done online at www.iccauburn.com, pick up a registration form in the gather space or stop by the parish office.

It is very important for all Catholics to be registered. This is especially important when you request letters of testimony to become a sponsor for baptism or confirmation or wishing to be married. Young adults over 18 years of age who are living at home and in the working world should be registered on their own. ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE DIOCESE



It remains important for our Church to protect children and young persons from the evils of abuse. The Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend remains committed to upholding and following its guidelines, policies and procedures that were implemented for the protection of children and young people. "Youth Protection."

If you have reason to believe that a minor may be a victim of child abuse or neglect, Indiana law requires that you report this to civil authorities. If you or someone you know was abused as a child or young person by an adult, you are encouraged to notify appropriate civil authorities of that abuse. In addition, if the alleged abuser is or was a priest or deacon of the Catholic Church, you are encouraged to contact Jodi Marlin, Victim Assistance Coordinator, at 260-399-1447 or jmarlin@diocesefwsb.org; or Rev. Mark Gurtner, Vicar General of the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend, at P.O. Box 390, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46801; at 260-399-1419; or at mgurtner@diocesefwsb.org. The diocese is committed to helping prevent the abuse or neglect of children and young people and to assist those who have suffered harm as a result of such abuse.

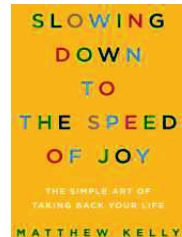

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's first reading from the Acts of the Apostles is iconic for how we are to live our Christian faith.

- Living the Church's teachings. Let's daily read good Catholic books. Check out our new parish library that was so beautifully done by Bill Vorndran and which is being maintained by Chris Grogg. More info on our library to come!
- Communal life. Do we each have a prayer group that we meet weekly/regularly with. Living the faith communally is part of the essence of our faith. This takes time to develop. Pray for the Lord to help put the group together.
- Breaking bread together and the prayers. Sunday and daily Masses, Eucharistic Adoration, Confession, prayer groups, retreats, conferences. Let's go!
- Signs and Wonders- are we befriending our neighbors and co-workers and asking the Holy Spirit to show us when the moment is for us to ask our new friends when we can pray with them for the Holy Spirit to work in their lives?
- Simplicity of life- "they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need." Let's look at our belongings and make sure we only have what we need for our mission to Christify the world and also to make sure we only have the amount of things we really need.
- Meals with people are important- for family life but also for evangelization. They ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart.
- They were in the world but not of the world- "...praising God and enjoying favor with all of the people." Rule #1: Don't be weird. Haha!
- The early Christians loved each other sincerely but also knew that a major part of their call was to grow in numbers. "And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved." Every year, each of us should be bringing in at least one person to join the OCIA and become Catholic. Are we taking our faith seriously if we are not striving to get people to the OCIA? Each of us should see ourselves as fishermen for the OCIA. Yes, holiness and learning are vital but so is community growing. Do we really want to appear before Jesus at the end of time and have Him ask us: "Where are the others?"

Jesus is alive, let's believe and live like the first disciples and so find that sweet joy and love that never ends!

DIVINE MERCY IS FOR YOU

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated annually on the first Sunday after Easter. A Plenary Indulgence removes all temporal punishment due to forgiven sin ("Temporal punishment" is the "making up" for sin to which we are obliged after we are forgiven). A Plenary Indulgence can be applied to one's self or to anyone who is deceased. A Plenary Indulgence can be gained once per day.

ONE SPECIFIC WORK REQUIRED ON DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

In any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy.

OR

In the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!").

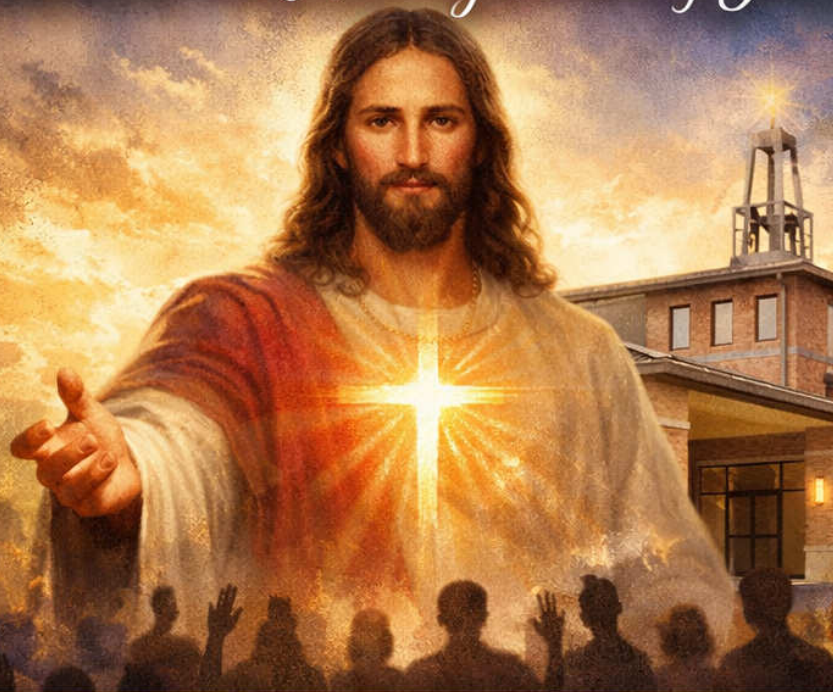

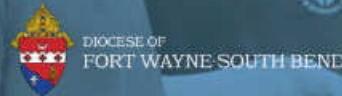
