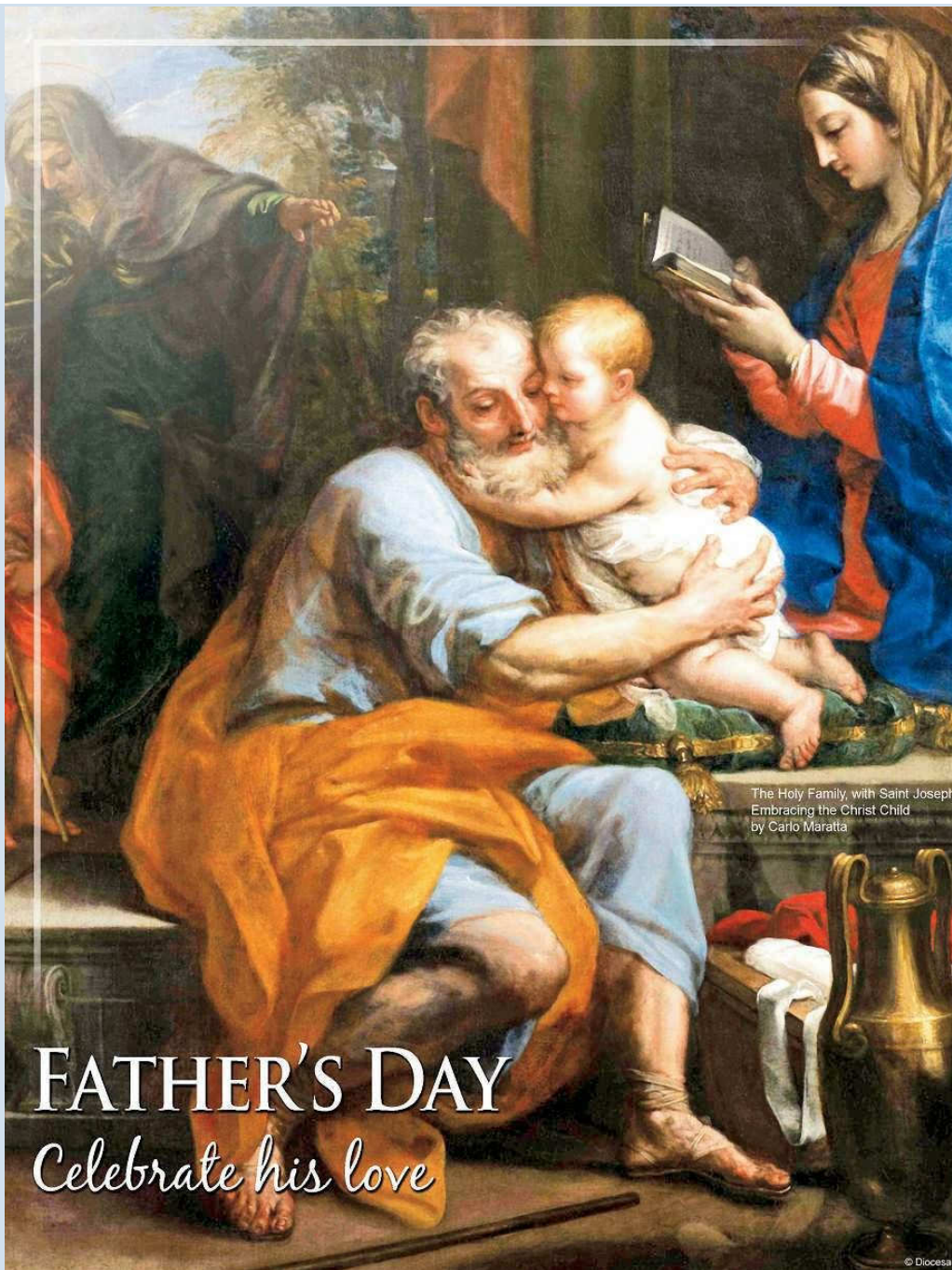

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Father Jake's Column

God the Origin of True Fatherhood

Seems fitting that on the weekend we celebrate Father's Day, we receive a gospel passage about how valuable we are in the Father's sight. We hear Jesus say to us, "Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows." It is from our father's that we first began to understand God as our Father. What a role to fill and simultaneously what a burden to bear, so we ask for God's blessing upon all the fathers in our parish.

Every father leaves an imprint on his children. Some beautiful, some painful. But beneath every earthly father stands the One Father from whom every fatherhood takes its name. The vocation of every father is not to draw attention to himself but to become transparent enough that his children can begin to recognize the face of God.

Ultimately, this is my role as your pastor, to help reveal the Father through my ministry as a priest of Jesus Christ. I hope to do this well, but I cannot achieve anything without the support of your prayers. Know that once I found out in April that I was moving to Immaculate Conception Church, you were being remembered in my daily prayers.

I look forward to this new mission as the priest of Auburn. This is a new experience not only as a pastor but also in a smaller church. I grew up at St. Charles Borromeo in Fort Wayne and then spent my first 3 years as a priest at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. I have only known for most of my life the big parish mentality. I very much welcome the new pace and parish life here. Most of all, I look forward to growing in my discipleship of Jesus alongside you.

May our Lady of the Immaculate Conception intercede for us and keep us close to her Son.

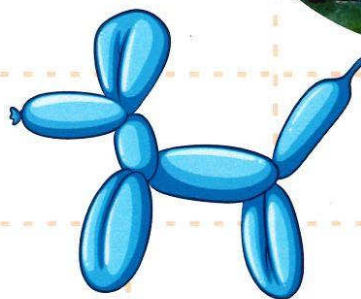
