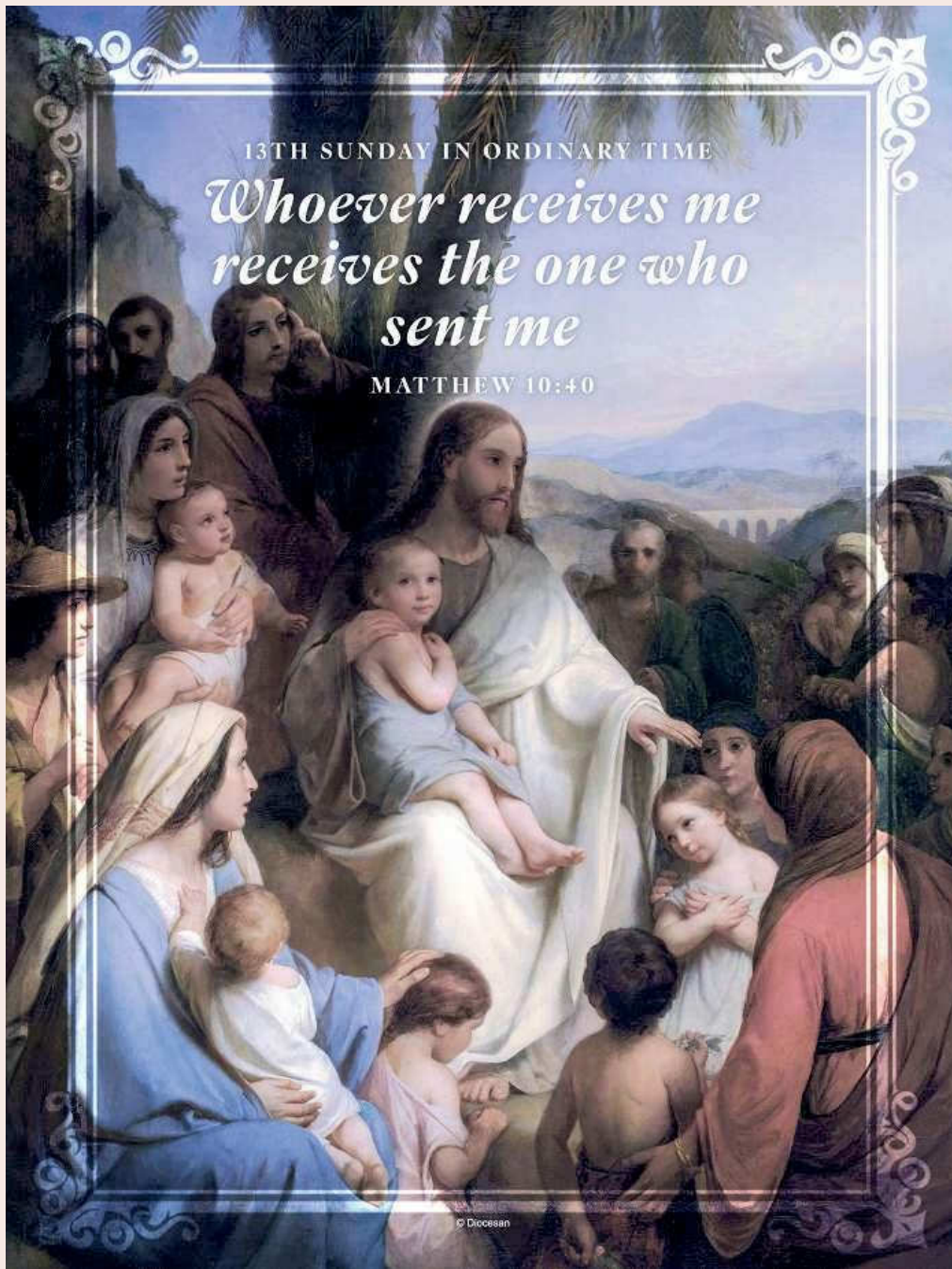

SOLEMNITY OF SAINT PETER AND SAINT PAUL JUNE 29

We honor the two great apostles Peter and Paul. Saint Peter, one of the Twelve and the chief of the Apostles, The Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and Saint Paul “called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God” (Romans 1:1) and Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of Emperor Nero.

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Father Jake's Column

First Impressions

I was taught when I was younger that first impressions are very important. In as little as a tenth of a second a person forms an impression about you. That judgment often involves assessing a person's trustworthiness and competence. I wish to share with you my first impressions of this parish because it may be helpful to recognize what a newcomer may experience. However, I realize that my first impressions and interactions are shaped significantly by my role as priest.

This campus is “immaculate.” Yes, the campus is beautiful and well kept. It reveals an intentional order and even a service to those who drive by or happen to come onto our campus. The beauty of the campus undoubtedly leaves an impression on those who drive or walk by. I had a priest that always compared the church building and grounds to a bank. If we entered a bank and found it messy, disorganized, and with no one ready to help us, how could we trust it with our valuable assets? The same is true for us. If we want people to entrust their immortal souls to the care of our parish, we should convey that we are organized, intentional, and ready to serve them well.

On my first weekend, many people came up to me ready to offer their help. “Father if there is anything you need, please let us know.” As a priest, it is very reassuring to hear such a willingness to serve. It truly reflects the heart of Christ, who came not to be served but to serve. I hope that whenever we see someone new—or someone who simply looks lost—we have the courage to introduce ourselves and help them find a home here.

First impressions are important, but I do recognize that is only the surface and I do not wish to only “judge a book by its cover.” In the coming weeks, I plan to meet with many people so that I can gain a deeper understanding of this parish than first impressions alone can provide. If you serve in any capacity here, you can expect an email or phone call to arrange a meeting. If you have already requested a meeting, I will gladly accommodate you.

My hope is that by the end of the summer I will have learned enough of the parish's history, heard enough of its stories, recognized what works well, and understood what changes have been difficult or unhelpful so that I can bring the councils together to discern the path forward. My hope is that by the end of the calendar year, each of you will have had an opportunity to sit down with me and share your concerns, hopes, and dreams for our parish.

May Sts. Peter and Paul – whose solemnity we celebrate on June 29, pray for us!

Getting to Know Father Jake Schneider

Father Jake grew up on Ft. Wayne's north side. He was a member of St. Charles Borromeo Parish, where he also went to grade school. He later attended Bishop Dwenger High School, where he played soccer. After graduating from high school, Father Jake attended the University of Toledo, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Exercise Science. He then answered God's call to the priesthood and entered Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland. Father Jake was ordained to the priesthood on June 3, 2023. Father Jake comes to us from St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Ft. Wayne. In addition to his duties at Immaculate Conception Parish, Bishop Rhoades will also rely on Father Jake for Vocations Promotion in the diocese.

Father Jake is the oldest of three children born to Tina and Andy Schneider. His younger sister is a Physician Assistant with Parkview Health and occasionally serves in the emergency department at Parkview DeKalb. His brother-in-law is a Physical Therapist at Choice Physical Therapy in Auburn, and his father, Andy, works at Auburn Gear. With so many connections to the Auburn community, it seems clear that God was at work in leading Father Jake to our parish. What may appear to be a series of coincidences instead reflects God's loving hand, preparing the way for Father Jake to become part of our parish family and to share his ministry with us.

One of Father Jake's greatest joys as a priest is celebrating the sacraments and witnessing God at work in the lives of His people. Father Jake is passionate about helping others come to know Jesus and grow in a personal relationship with Him. Father Jake's desire is to help every parishioner deepen that relationship and experience the joy of a living faith. Father Jake also looks forward to getting to know everyone in the parish personally. His hope is that, over time, he will be able to look out at the congregation and know each parishioner by name, fostering a strong sense of community, connection, and belonging within our parish family.
