Father Jake's Column

Pastor+

I wanted to give you all a little insight into my life as a priest. I see my role as the pastor of this parish as my main priority of service and indeed the most important to my life as a priest. However, I am a "Pastor+." That "+" sign signifies the other three roles and jobs that I have incurred as my time being a priest. I believe this to be new for our parish, I am not aware of our former pastors having two assignments as they served as pastor.

My other assignment for the diocese is Co-Director of Vocation Promotions. The position is fairly new for our diocese and I share it with another priest. The position is to help recruit young men to consider the priesthood. This role requires me to spend time in the curia downtown in Fort Wayne and to visit other parishes and even some of the schools and universities to form relationships with the young men of our diocese. It will also include helping young people of our diocese discern a vocation to the consecrated life. I am not sure of the full responsibilities in this role, so we will discover that together.

My next role for the diocese is temporary as chaplain for World Youth Day. Next summer in August of 2027, our diocese will be on pilgrimage to Seoul, South Korea for World Youth Day with the Holy Father and a large gathering of Catholics around the world. Bishop Rhoades has asked me to be the spiritual chaplain to help those pilgrims prepare and organize the priests and seminarians to serve our young pilgrims as they experience this great encounter with Christ and a large portion of His church.

Finally, my last role is Chaplain for Fraternus Ranch. Fraternus is a brotherhood of fathers inducting young men into what it means to be a Christian man. It can be best thought of as a young boys youth group that teaches virtue so that they can become men. My last parish had a very successful chapter of Fraternus. The "Ranch" is the summer retreat that takes place in Tennessee. This is where I am heading this upcoming week and next weekend. I will be serving as the spiritual chaplain for about 500 men from July 6-12.

I'll be honest, it is difficult to be away so early on in this new assignment, but when I had agreed to serve in this role that year, I had no idea I would be moved and be given new responsibilities. You will be in my prayers this week.

As I said last week, many people approached me offering their service to this parish, I would ask first for your prayers. Second, I will be looking for the gifts the Holy Spirit has given you to help build up this parish. We will need to rely and help each other for our parish family to be healthy, vibrant, and sustain growth. I will ask you to be proactive, ask Jesus, "Lord, how do you want me to serve in our parish?" He might place a particular ministry on your heart or we may discover a new need within our parish. So don't be surprised in these coming months, if I ask for your help because I will need it. Thank you for your faithfulness to our parish!

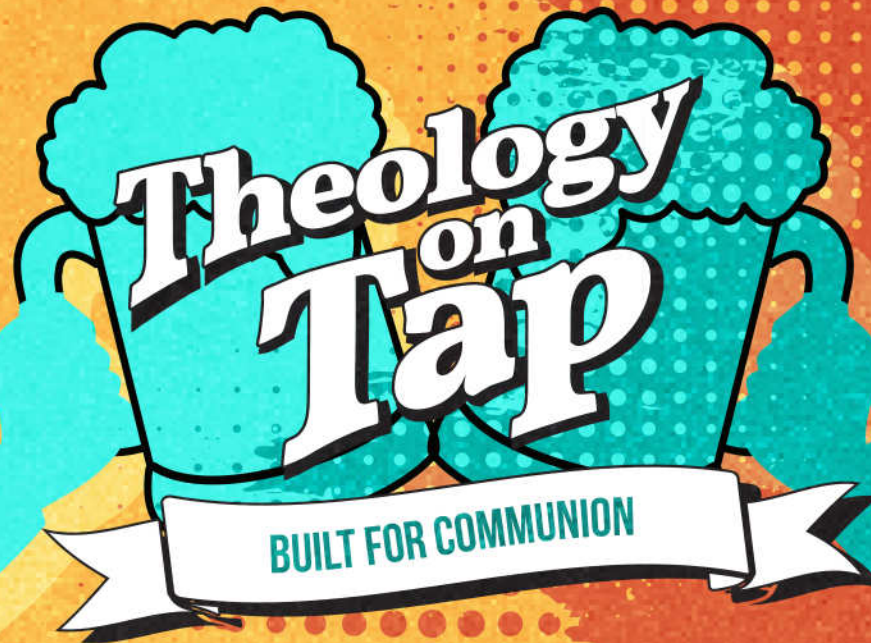

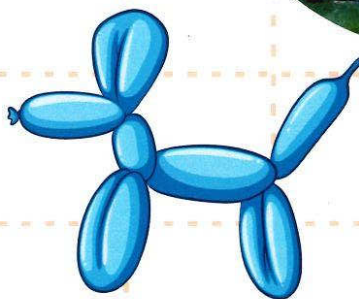

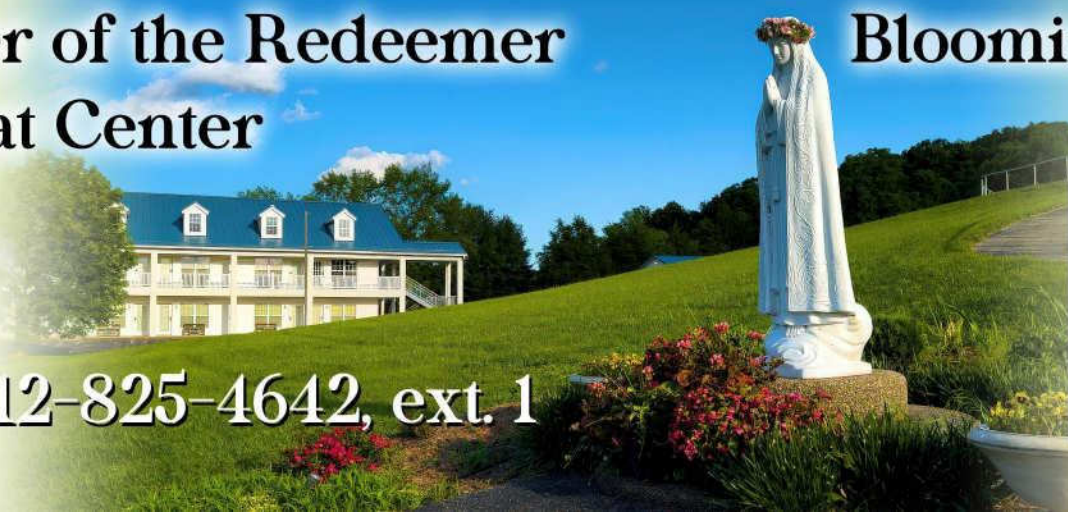
