Do you know someone who is interested in learning more about the Catholic faith? Perhaps you are thinking about what it means to be called to the Catholic way of life.



The church has a process called the **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults** (O.C.I.A.) whereby adults can learn and discern whether to become Catholic Christians. The process leads an unbaptized adult to his or her baptism, usually at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. If the adult has been baptized in another Christian tradition, then the process prepares the person to be received into the Catholic Church by making a *Profession of Faith* as a Catholic. The process also prepares the way for someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church to receive First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Father Jake's Column

I am very grateful to priests who have celebrated the sacraments this week, especially Msgr. Bob Schulte for the weekend liturgies.

The gospel you heard this weekend is one of my favorites because it holds the key to Jesus' words and miracles. Jesus wants us to see his ministry as, in the first reading, as rain come down from heaven preparing the environment for the eternal seed to be received. He is both the waters of grace that prepares the soil and the eternal seed to be planted within us. Once we grasp that Jesus not only gives us what we need (the eternal seed) but also prepares us to receive (the proper soil), then begins the long patience process of growth.

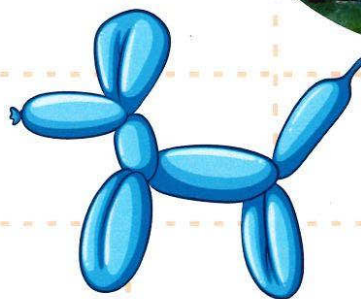

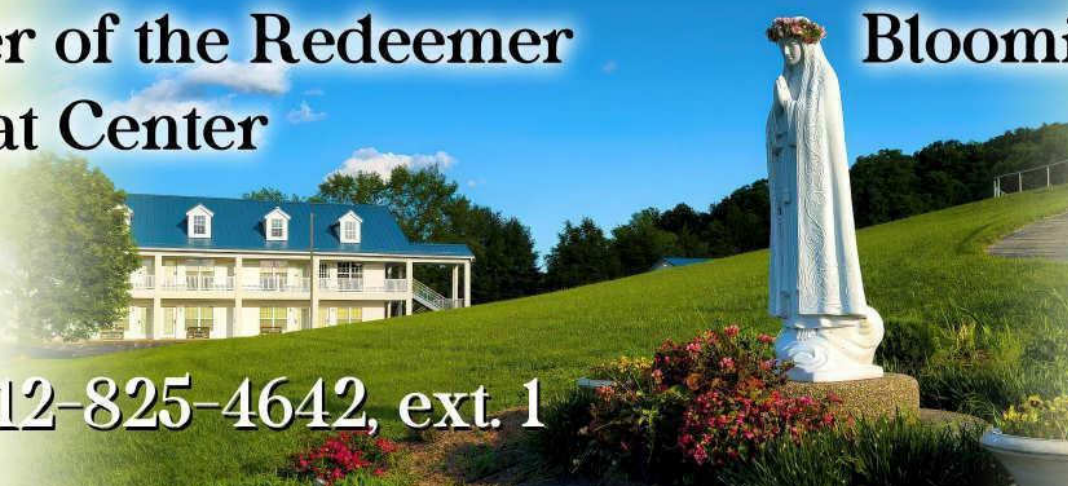
