Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

To be a neighbor is to develop the art of hospitality. We see today in the Gospel that Jesus wants us to be a neighbor to everyone especially in engaging with people where they are hurting.

Samaritans were considered to be a kind of unfaithful, faraway, half-Jewish person yet this was the person that responded with hospitality when the moment arrived.

The Samaritan poured oil and wine on the wounds of the person left half-dead and even took the person to an inn for recovery.

May we develop the art of hospitality in our lives; the art of being a neighbor. If a Samaritan can do it, then we can do it all the more. We are called to closeness with God and then to bring this closeness to others. The oil and wine that we pour out is our love and prayer from the heart where we pray for the Holy Spirit and Precious Blood to flood the person we are interacting with at the moment or even from afar we pray for people we know may need this prayer, especially to pray particularly for the place in their lives that need it.

The inn that we draw people to is our parish where Jesus, the pastor, and community can help with continual and full love, joy, faith, and healing. The parish is an inn or a field hospital for us to bring people to.

Baptized Catholics and the Catholic parish are the future of the world. Let's become who we are. This is not difficult. We simply need to live in the Spirit and respond where we see the Spirit and moment is calling. We heard in our first reading today:

"For this command that I enjoin on you today is not too mysterious and remote for you. It is not up in the sky, that you should say, 'Who will go up in the sky to get it for us and tell us of it, that we may carry it out?' Nor is it across the sea, that you should say, 'Who will cross the sea to get it for us and tell us of it, that we may carry it out?' No, it is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out."
