



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Last week, we heard about the importance of wasting time with Jesus like Mary of Bethany. This wasting time with Jesus can be in praise, conversation, silence, and other prayers like the Rosary, Eucharistic Adoration, etc.

This week, I would like to look at the Gospel through the same invitation to spiritual refreshment in our friendship with Jesus. In the Gospel today, Jesus taught His disciples the Our Father prayer. How wonderful it is to be Jesus' brother or sister in Baptism and then be able to pray this prayer with Him. When we pray this prayer, we should also have the prayer in our hearts: Jesus, show me our Father. Jesus is the image of the Father and He is also the power to place us in the Father's love.

When I pray the Our Father prayer by myself, especially during the Rosary, I am reminded to slow down. The Our Father prayer is not something that we memorize and then mindlessly run by but it sure is easy to do so. The Our Father prayer said with Jesus from with heart and with the mind is life giving.

Almost every time I pray the Our Father, I am reminded about how St. Therese of Lisieux recommended praying the Our Father when we feel like our spirit has run dry. She said to pray the prayer slowly imagining that each word is a pebble that we are tossing into the pond. This is probably a good idea to do whether we feel spiritual dryness or not. Imagine how good it would be to take five minutes and just pray the Our Father slowly while thoughtfully thinking of each word. This conscious and loving prayer of the Our Father will restore our soul just as Mary of Bethany felt refreshed sitting at the feet of Jesus in friendship.

We have a good Father who loves us and has given us His heart to us in Jesus. With Jesus, let us allow ourselves to be lifted up to the Father and be renewed in His love and joy.


