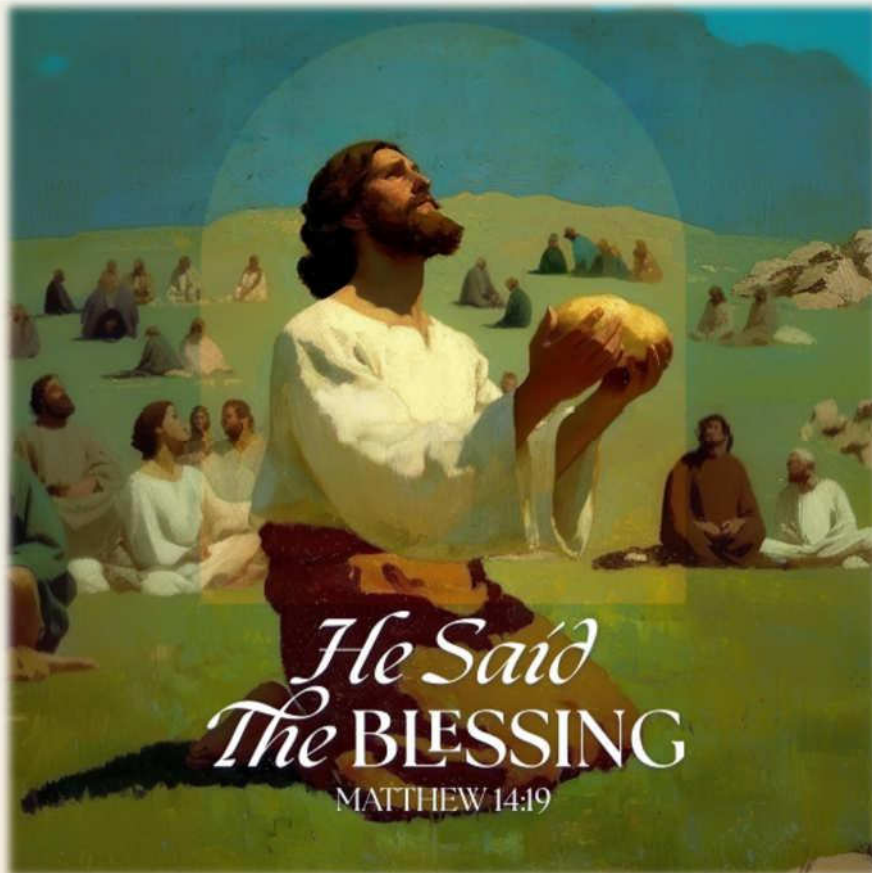

Solanus Casey lived a life marked by simplicity, suffering, and quiet faithfulness. As a Capuchin Franciscan friar, he was ordained a simplex priest and assigned primarily as a porter, welcoming visitors at the monastery door.

By the world's standards, his role seemed insignificant. Yet God used that doorway to touch thousands of lives. Father Solanus Casey instructed the other friars to provide food, famously saying, "They are hungry; get them some soup and sandwiches". Before the **Mass for the Sick and Troubled, soup will be served, followed by Rosary at 12:30 p.m. and Mass at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 15.**

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Father Jake's Column

The Domestic Church

Lumen Gentium, which is Latin for *Light of the Nations*, is one of the sacred constitutions of the Second Vatican Council. It articulates that Christ is the Light to the Nations through the Catholic Church. Every baptized person carries the light of Christ to the world sharing in the mission of Christ. Before one can carry their light to the world, one must first recognize the light they carry. We learn how to cultivate the little shimmer into a burning fire of love that the world will not be able to snuff out. The place where we first learn is through our family, which the constitution calls *the domestic church*:

"The family is, so to speak, the domestic church. In it parents should, by their word and example, be the first preachers of the faith to their children; they should encourage them in the vocation which is proper to each of them, fostering with special care vocation to a sacred state (*LG*, 11)."

Every single father and mother is tasked with educating their children in the faith. You are the primary teachers and the Church exists to help you in your task. In working together, we will mutually enrich one another. I recently came across a book called *The Intentional Household, Living as if People Matter* by John Cuddleback. I would recommend purchasing it and reading it to reestablish your household as a domestic church. I will also provide for you some of my reflections in the coming weeks.

Dr. Cuddleback proposes 8 principles to reclaim the household as a place for family culture, true rest through leisure, and a vulnerable community. He recognizes a cultural shift in our home life that doesn't easily attain these things. The home was once the center of work, play, and generations of family. Now all these things are outsourced - we work away from the home, we play away from the home, and every generation moves out and comes back for a few hours on a holiday.

I wish to share with you these principles in order to transform your own lives - to rediscover the joy of living the gospel. And simultaneously, your joy will draw people to the source of our light - Jesus Christ. We must live differently from the rest of the world, valuing higher truths, and through our domestic church revealing to the world a greater way to live and flourish. I will introduce the first principle in the next column.

As always, the domestic church begins with prayer. May we continue to seek out Our Mother, Mary, through our devotion to her. Pray the rosary this week.

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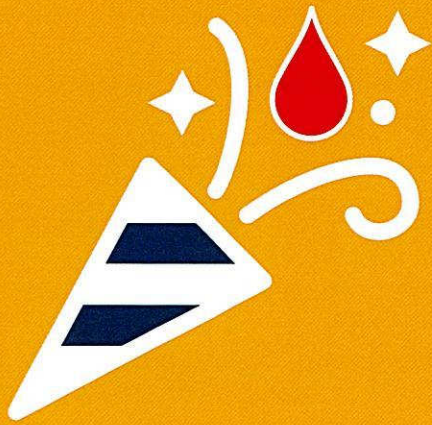
