Do you know someone who is interested in learning more about the Catholic faith? Perhaps you are thinking about what it means to be called to the

Catholic way of life.

The church has a process called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (O.C.I.A.) whereby adults can learn and discern whether to become Catholic Christians. The process leads an unbaptized adult to his or her baptism, usually at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. If the adult has been baptized in another Christian tradition, then the process prepares the person the be received into the Catholic Church by making a Profession of Faith as a Catholic. The process also prepares the way for someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church to receive First Holy Communion and Confirmation. To learn more and to get signed up for the next session contact the parish office or speak with Father Drew.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

During "Ordinary Time" (the time of the church liturgical year when the priest wears green vestments) we focus on Jesus' three year earthly mission from His Baptism in the Jordan until His Death and Resurrection. During Jesus' earthly mission, His headquarters was in Capernaum on the Sea of Galilee, which is the hometown of Peter, Andrew, James, and John. However, most of His time was spent on foot walking throughout Israel preaching the Kingdom of God. During these three years, Jesus only owned what was necessary for His mission of preaching and working in the power of the Holy Spirit. The carpentry life of Nazareth was behind Him and the life of Heaven was still ahead of Him. The mission was spent striving to gather people to become the Church.

I would encourage us this week to ask the Holy Spirit to show us how we can grow in our missionary spirit individually and as a parish. What is needed in order to fulfill our mission of gathering people to become the Church here at Immaculate Conception? Christ's lay faithful still live their Nazareth dimension of life (family, work, civil life, leisure, etc.) but are also called to live the missionary dimension as well.

Each person and parish is called to discern what the harmony of these two things looks like in each situation. Nazareth and mission to grow the Church. This will allow us to flourish in this life but also build up treasure in Heaven for ourselves and others. Come Holy Spirt and show us how to live as missionary disciples in the world.
