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Father Jake's Column

That They May All Be One

As a parish, we are blessed whenever someone comes to know Jesus Christ and, through the grace of God, discovers the fullness of faith and life that He has entrusted to His Church. There is something beautiful about seeing someone discover that they have not simply found a parish—they have found a home.

In John 17, Jesus gives us a glimpse into the depths of His heart. On the eve of His Passion, He prays not only for the Apostles gathered around Him, but for all those who will come to believe in Him through their preaching. His prayer is simple and profound:

**"That they may all be one, as you,
Father, are in me and I in you."**

The unity Jesus desires for His disciples is not merely friendship or agreement. It is a profound communion—a sharing in the very unity that exists between the Father and the Son. Jesus entrusts this unity to the Apostles. He sends them as He Himself was sent by the Father, giving them the mission of teaching, sanctifying, and shepherding His people.

That apostolic mission did not end with the first generation of Christians. It continues in the Church through the successors of the Apostles, our bishops, who remain united with one another and with the Successor of Peter. To be united with the Catholic Church, therefore, is to be united with the apostolic Church that Christ Himself established. It is to receive the faith handed down from the Apostles and to share in the sacramental life through which Christ continues to give Himself to His people.

What a beautiful gift that is! Our communion with the Catholic Church is not something separate from our relationship with Jesus. Christ does not call us to follow Him alone and apart from His Body. He calls us into His Church, into communion with one another, with the Apostles and their successors, and ultimately into deeper union with Himself.

This is why welcoming new disciples into the Catholic Church is such a joy for our parish. We are not simply welcoming people to our parish; we are welcoming people home. We are welcoming brothers and sisters into the family of God and into the communion Christ prayed for on the night before He gave His life for us.

For some, that home may be discovered after years of searching. For others, it may feel like a return to something they have always longed for. Whatever their journey, we have the privilege of accompanying them, forming them in the faith, and rejoicing as they come to know the Lord more deeply.

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Pilgrimage Host & Spiritual Director



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A 12-Day Pilgrimage to the Shrines & Cathedrals of France

Day 1: Friday, November 5, 2027

Depart via scheduled air service to Paris

Day 2: Saturday, November 6: Paris

Upon arrival in Paris, meet your Faith Journeys Tour Manager, who will assist the group to the awaiting chartered motorcoach for a panoramic tour of Paris to see the Eiffel Tower, L'Arc de Triomphe, and Champs-Élysées. We will also see the Basilica of the Sacred Heart (Sacré-Coeur) Depending on timing – attend Mass at Sacré Coeur (6 pm public mass in French). Late afternoon check-in at the hotel. Evening Welcome Dinner and overnight

Day 3: Sunday, November 7: Paris

Attend Mass at the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, site of three apparitions of the Virgin Mary in 1830. Visit the Tomb of St. Vincent de Paul in the Chapel of the Vincentians. Continue our tour with a visit of Notre Dame and continue to Sainte-Chapelle, a 13th-century Gothic chapel in the heart of Paris. Enjoy time at leisure for additional sightseeing, reflection, or other activities. Evening dinner and overnight

Day 4: Monday, November 8: Paris / Beauvais / Amiens / Lisieux

This morning, we will visit the incomplete Cathedral of St. Peter of Beauvais. It is, in some respects, the most daring achievement in Gothic architecture. Continue to Amiens Cathedral in the heart of Picardy. Prior to lunch, on own, Mass will be said in the Cathedral (Private Mass). Enjoy time at leisure for additional sightseeing, reflection, or other activities. Travel to Lisieux for evening dinner and overnight

Day 5: Tuesday, November 9: Lisieux / Chartres

Visit the Martin family house, where Saint Therese lived until she entered the Carmel Convent, and the great Basilica of Saint Therese. Say Mass at the Tomb of St. Therese in the Chapel of the Carmelite Monastery. Continue to Chartres to visit its magnificent Cathedral. Chartres Cathedral has been a major pilgrimage destination since the early Middle Ages and has a spirit of holiness that impresses even the most resolute of nonbelievers. Evening dinner and overnight

Day 6: Wednesday, November 10: Bourges / Paray-le-Monial

On our way to Paray-le-Monial, stop in Bourges to visit its 13th-century cathedral dedicated to St. Stephen. The site occupied by the present cathedral has been the site of the city's main church at least since Carolingian times. Continue to Paray-le-Monial, home to St. Margaret Mary and the Shrine of the Sacred Heart. Visit the Church of St. Claude de Colombière and the Chapel of the Visitation, where St. Margaret Mary received her visions. A private Mass will be said at the Chapelle de la Visitation, if available. Evening dinner and overnight

Day 7: Thursday, November 11: Le Puy-en-Velay

Depart for Le Puy-en-Velay, home of the Motherhouse for the Sisters of St. Joseph. Le Puy is known for its tradition of pilgrimage and a historic Marian apparition in the first century AD. The shrine features a replica of a Black Madonna statue and is the starting point for one of the routes of the Camino de Santiago. Tour the city and the recently purchased house, and the center. If space is available, celebrate a private Mass in the center. Enjoy lunch and some free time in Le Puy
Dinner will be on your own, allowing everyone to explore the fantastic food for which the city is known

Day 8: Friday, November 12: Lyon

Transfer to Lyon. Upon arrival in Lyon, enjoy a guided tour of Lyon ending with a trip just outside of the city to Fourvière and a visit to the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière, say Mass at the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière (Private Mass). Check into your hotel and enjoy dinner on your own in one of the best food cities in the world.

Day 9: Saturday, November 13: St. Francis de Sales

Check out of your hotel and board your coach for Annecy, traveling through the beautiful countryside and wine country of Burgundy to the shores of Lake Annecy. Visit Annecy Castle, the residence of the Counts of Geneva. Tour the Monastery of the Visitation and Basilica. It was here that St. Francis de Sales was buried in 1623. Many miracles have been reported at his shrine. Continue to the village of Thorens to celebrate Mass at the De Sales Chapel. Visit Château Thorens, the ancient family residence of the De Sales family. Evening dinner and overnight

Day 10: Sunday, November 14: The French & Swiss Alps

A 90-minute drive by motor coach through the picturesque Arve Valley takes you from Annecy to Chamonix, one of the most famous mountain villages at the foot of the remarkable and majestic Mont Blanc. Enjoy time at leisure for additional sightseeing, reflection, or other activities. Travel to the Italian ski village of Courmayeur to enjoy amazing vistas surrounding the mountains before returning to Annecy. Dinner and overnight. Overnight at hotel

Day 11: Monday, November 15: Geneva

Morning check-out and transfer to Geneva. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided city tour, visiting the main sites of Geneva. Enjoy a free afternoon exploring the city on your own. In the late afternoon, meet your coach and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Then, travel to a local restaurant for a special celebration dinner. Overnight in Geneva (airport area hotel)

Day 12: Tuesday, November 16: Return Home

Transfer to Geneva Airport for the return flight
