Position Summary:

The Community Engagement Coordinator is a vital member of the Mississippi Council on Economic Education team, responsible for implementing and supporting high-impact community-based financial literacy programs. The Coordinator will lead efforts to organize and deliver the **Stock Market Game** and **Danny Dollar Academy** in after-school settings, plan and facilitate **Family Financial Fun Nights**, and coordinate the **Invest in Girls** initiative across the state. Responsibilities include location selection, recruitment of industry professionals as volunteers, delivering educator professional development, data analysis and extensive monthly reporting. This role requires extensive in-state travel (50% or more) and the ability to work with diverse stakeholders to expand MCEE's reach and impact.

Key Responsibilities:

• Program Planning & Implementation:

- Organize and deliver the Stock Market Game and Danny Dollar Academy in after-school programs.
- Plan and facilitate Family Financial Fun Nights in collaboration with community partners.
- Coordinate the Invest in Girls initiative, including:
 - Determining appropriate program sites across Mississippi.
 - Recruiting and engaging female professionals from the finance industry to serve as guest speakers, mentors, or panelists.
 - Overseeing event logistics and student engagement activities tailored to high school girls.

- Recruit participants, educators, schools, and volunteers for Family Financial Fun Nights and after-school initiatives.
- Cultivate partnerships with schools, after-school programs, youth organizations, and community groups.
- Build a network of financial professionals to support student learning and engagement through programs like Invest in Girls.

- Facilitate interactive, engaging Family Financial Fun Nights and studentfocused programs statewide.
- Provide professional development for after-school educators in personal finance education and effective program delivery.

Data Management & Reporting:

- o Collect, manage, and analyze participant data for all community programs.
- Prepare program evaluations, success metrics, and impact reports for internal use and funder reporting.

Collaboration & Communication:

- Represent MCEE in public forums, conferences, and community outreach events.
