

How to get the 915 Entrepreneurship Supplemental Endorsement

This is an "add on" supplemental endorsement that may be earned only by persons who hold a currently valid secondary level educator license in one of the following:

105 Business Education (7-12)
405 Business Management
952 Career Pathway: Finance and Accounting
955 Career Pathway: Management
956 Career Pathway: Marketing
192 Social Studies (7-12)
193 Economics (7-12)

A #915 endorsement allows a person to teach the following course:

990003 Entrepreneurship

How to get the endorsement?

- 1. Applicant must hold a bachelor's degree and currently valid secondary educator license with one of the following endorsements: 105, 405, 952, 956, 955, 193, or 192.
- 2. Applicant must validate technology competency by attaining the established minimum score or higher on an assessment approved by the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE). The assessment must be directly related to technology competency required by the grade level and subject matter being taught. Approved assessments for this license are IC3 or other approved MDE
- 3. Complete the Master Teacher of Entrepreneurship (MTEnt) program offered by MCEE at which time you will be provided with a certificate noting your completion of the MTEnt program for your use in applying for the endorsement. Please retain a copy for your records.
- 4. Applicant must successfully complete a certification for an online learning workshop, module, or course that is approved by the Mississippi Department of Education. Submit the Career and Technical Education Application along with your certificates of completion to the Office of Educator Licensure. The application can be accessed at

Note: If the applicant meets all requirements listed above, that applicant will be issued a 915 endorsement—a five-year license. If the applicant meets one of the required endorsements requirements, but does not meet all other requirements, the applicant may be issued a three-year endorsement (license), and all requirements stated above must be satisfied prior to the ending date of that license.
