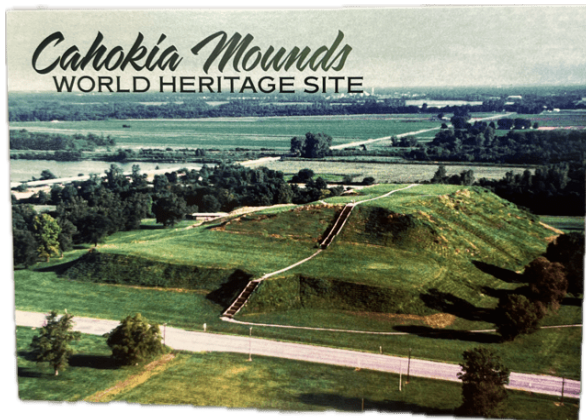
January 13 (Tuesday) – You provide the sack lunch at 11:30 and Greg will provide information about Realm.

February 10 (Tuesday) – Lori Williams is once again catering a meal for us at 11:30 and then Annie Schomaker (or other representatives from Eden's Glory) will present a seminar about childhood trauma and the connections to human trafficking.

March 10 (Tuesday) – Our trip to the St. Louis Arch in 2025 had to be canceled because of the government shut-down, so we are rescheduling it for this day. We will have the ride to the top and then enjoy both the movie and a self-guided tour of the museum.

April 14 (Tuesday) – [Tentative] Cahokia Mounds is a U. S. National Historic Landmark and UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is the largest pre-Columbian site north of Mexico. At its peak about 1100 A.D. Cahokia Mounds covered 4,000 acres and had a population of nearly 20,000

individuals -- larger than London at that time. We will visit the Interpretive Center, walk around the grounds and even climb the steps up Monk's Mound. . . or not 😊



May 5 (Tuesday) – The Free Methodist pastor of the Alton Mission is Peter Hough. He had agreed to give us a guided tour of some of the stories and sites in Alton that are closely connected to the struggle for civil rights in our nation. You won't want to miss this day!
