Election on Sundays, April 26, and May 3 or during office hours between those dates

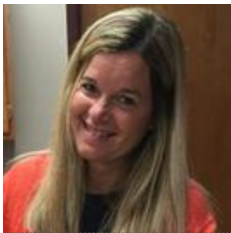
Voting must be done in-person. You will vote for three.

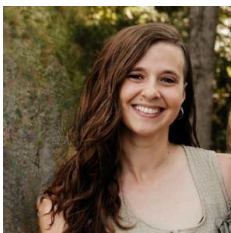
