Message from Pastor Steve Pichaske: "For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome." ~1 John 5:3 Ugh...more rules? Cosmic killjoy? I thought we were "Free" Methodists? I don't really like to be told what to do. Isn't Christianity all about having and growing into a personal relationship with God? Yes...But...Christianity may be grounded in a personal relationship with God through Jesus, but Christianity is also "communal," marked by the commandment to "love your neighbors." Christianity is inherently relational...and every good relationship needs guidance to keep those relationships healthy. What if God's Ten Words were not given to restrict our freedom but to enhance our happiness?
