- Adult Growth Class in C101/103 Led by Lucia Delamarter The Book of Judges narrates one of the most chaotic and morally dark eras of Israel's story. Many speak of it as Israel's "Wild West," where the heroes and the villains stand only inches apart. Into this morally-ambiguous time comes one of the most unlikely leaders of the biblical text—the prophet Deborah. She is a wife and mother in an entirely patriarchal world, yet due to her integrity and courage, she transforms chaos into order and leads Israel in one of the most pivotal victories of the settlement period. Illustrating the era of the Judges by means of the archaeological record, historical geography, and the hard facts of warfare in the ancient world, this video study by Dr Sandra Richter draws students immediately into the grand tale of Deborah and Barak, Jabin and Sisera, and of course, the most unlikely of leaders, Jael.
- Bible Basics Growth Class in C107, led by Ray Myers: Light Enters the Darkness: John's Gospel of Jesus' Life
- Growth Class in FMY Room (C104): Alison Lanter facilitates a five week class on the book 'Boundaries' by Henry Cloud and John Townsend.
