**Message from Pastor Steve Pichaske:** In 1989, Billy Joel included 119 references to global realities, including tragedy, scandal, and screw-ups in his iconic song, "We Didn't Start the Fire." His references included:

Ayatollah's in Iran, Russians in Afghanistan,

Hypodermics on the shore, China's under martial law,

Begin, Palestine, Terror on the Airline.

All before offering the now familiar refrain:

We didn't start the fire, it was always burning,

since the world's been turning.

We didn't start the fire, but when we are gone,

it will still burn on, and on, and on, and on.

We could easily replace these references to brokenness and despair with our own current experiences:

Campus shouting, factions forming, all this news of global warming,

Ceasefire talks again collapse, leaders caught up in another mess.

Wildfires roaring, marriages pleading, power brokers never heeding-

Still we scroll the endless feed, peace feels like a dying seed.

It all leaves us to wonder, "Is peace even possible in 2025?"

Not without Jesus!

Isaiah 9 foretells the Missing Peace that Jesus would one day come to offer the world: "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end."

Illustrating the era of the Judges by means of the archaeological record, historical geography, and the hard facts of warfare in the ancient world, this video study by Dr Sandra Richter draws students immediately into the grand tale of Deborah and Barak, Jabin and Sisera, and of course, the most unlikely of leaders, Jael.
