Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Bosque County Emergency Services District No. 1 will be held on **Thursday, May 21, 2020, at 3:00 p.m.**, at the District office, 305 E. Morgan, Meridian, Texas, for the following purposes:

Due to the state of emergency and/or local disaster caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board of Commissioners of Bosque County Emergency Services District No. 1 may hold its meeting via telephone conference call because of the difficulty and risks of convening a quorum in one location. If initiated, the call will be broadcast at the meeting location and recorded as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act.

1. Call meeting to order;
2. Pledge of Allegiance;
3. Public Comment: In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.
4. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Members of the public may comment on any agenda item listed below. Members of the public may speak for up to two minutes per agenda item on which they comment.

5. Discuss and consider minutes of the April 16, 2020, regular meeting;
6. Discuss and consider Treasurer's report and the payment of rent, invoices, advertising expenses, and reimbursements owed to Commissioners for out-of-pocket expenses;
7. Discuss and consider any revenue transfers among District accounts;
8. Discuss and consider amendments to FY20 budget, if needed;

9. Receive monthly report from North Bosque EMS regarding emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities, personnel and membership and take any related action;

10. Receive monthly report from Bosque Valley First Responders Organization regarding emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities, personnel and membership and take any related action;
11. Receive status report from Commissioners on District-related work since the previous month's meeting;

12. Discuss and consider action regarding District website and required posting of budget and tax planning information;
13. Discuss time, place, date and agenda items for next meeting.
