1. Call meeting to order;
2. Public Comment: Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of fifteen minutes on items not on the current agenda. Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of two minutes on items not on the current agenda. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.
3. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Members of the public may comment on any agenda item listed below. Members of the public may speak for up to two minutes per agenda item on which they comment.
