1. Call meeting to order;
2. Public Comment: In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.
3. Public Comment on Agenda Items: Members of the public may comment on any agenda item listed below. Members of the public may speak for up to two minutes per agenda item on which they comment.

4. Conduct a public hearing on the proposal to increase property taxes;

13. Take a record vote on the District's 2026 tax rate, adopt an Order Levying Taxes and authorize filing the Order with the Bosque County Tax Assessor/Collector;
14. Acknowledge and approve posting of statement regarding adopted tax rate to home page of District website;
15. Discuss and consider action on stations, including renovations to existing stations and the new Meridian station, and issues related to the operation or maintenance of the stations;
16. Discuss time, place, date and agenda items for next meeting; and
17. Adjourn.
