A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

For 36 years, Lake Travis United Methodist Church has been a place of grace and generosity. It has been a long road from meeting in a strip mall to the beautiful campus God has so richly blessed us with. We're eternally thankful, not only to God, but for the faithfulness and servant's hearts of all those who came before us.

It is now our turn to set the stage for our next generation of ministry. Over the next three years, *Free to Rise* will enable us to become debt-free, freeing thousands of dollars for ministry. By eliminating this debt, we'll repurpose more than \$200,000 per year, every year, for mission and ministry. I am already imagining how God will use those resources for His glory.

The possibilities of how, where, and what we can do in service to our Lord are endless. Not only the ways in which we reach out to Lakeway and the world — John Wesley said, "The world is my parish" — but the ways we care for our staff, campus, preschool, and worship experience, and how we connect technologically with our community and the next generation of LTUMC family. I have seen how debt can stifle creativity — it's time to get out from under it and foster new ministries so we can better share the Good News of Jesus Christ with the world.

Is this debt-free dream possible? As with most things, I go to Scripture for answers. Malachi 3:10 says, "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!"

I believe LTUMC has the capacity to be free from debt. And I'm convinced that when we're debt-free, we'll be *Free to Rise* to the purposes God has called us to, growing not only as a church, but in our own faith and in our connection with our community.

As you reflect and pray about your role and purpose in this opportunity before us, we invite you to join us in a simple daily prayer: God, what do You want to do through me? God's answer to your prayer may place you in a new place financially, beyond your comfort zone, or past your anticipated limits. But if we individually and collectively pray together: "God, what do You want to do through me?" I believe we'll be **Free to Rise** to what and where God is calling us — to be "one in ministry to all the world."

Thirty-six years ago, a handful of area residents lead by Marsha Avery Kulpa, had a dream — to plant a United Methodist Church in Lakeway, Texas. By the grace of God, LTUMC was later chartered in 1989, and over the years the congregation has grown, moved, endured a global pandemic, declined, and is steadily rebuilding.

What started in a stripmall grew to a beautiful campus overlooking the Texas hill country. Our first structure — the Chesnutt Building (named after our first permanent pastor, Clyde Chesnutt) — was built in 1993; later becoming our Kids Center and Preschool. Later, the Worship Center was added, and in 2010, the Ministry Activities Center (aka the "MAC") became our third addition. Built with ministry in mind, the

MAC has faithfully served that purpose over the years — its kitchen has served thousands of meals, its common spaces have seen thousands experience the love of Christ, and its offices support local partners in ministry, including Partners in Hope, our Wesley Nurse, and most recently, Finding Hope — a mental wellness ministry.

For almost 40 years, the people of LTUMC have remained dedicated to loving God and loving our neighbors as ourselves, evidenced in countless ways, as we act as the hands and feet of our Lord. We now have over 45 ministries taking place on or through our campus and our people. What a beautiful legacy!

As we honor our past and celebrate the present, let us look forward to the next decade and beyond as we prepare ourselves to the missions, ministries, and people that God is calling us to next. \$\epsilon\$

WHO IS OUR MORTGAGE LENDER?

Our mortgage lender is Texas Methodist Foundation (TMF), the principal lender for Methodist churches in Texas, due to their flexibility and commitment to church growth and ministry success.

WHAT ARE OUR MORTGAGE TERMS?

Details of the mortgage are...

- 1—Balance: approximately \$1.99 million (at printing)
- 2—Note matures in just over 10 years (2036)
- 3—Annual interest rate will increase in 2026 from 4.15% to approximately
- 6%. Interest payments will increase approximately \$48,000 per year, starting in April 2026.
- 4—Our variable rate can be renegotiated periodically for the most favorable rate available.
- 5—Our annual payments will be approximately \$260,000 with principal and interest starting in April 2026.

WHY IS OUR INTEREST RATE GOING UP?

Unlike your typical home loan, TMF mortgage rates are not locked for the duration of the loan. An adjustable-rate mortgage is the industry standard for church loans. TMF offers floating, 3- and 5-year terms, as well as allowing no-cost renegotiations at the church's discretion as interest rates change. The reason our interest rate will increase is because our 5-year term will expire in a season where market rates are higher than during the end of the last 5-year term.

PREPARING FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS

Since 1989, Lake Travis United
Methodist Church has been a place
where people have made connections,
served their community, and most
importantly, experienced the lifegiving love of Jesus Christ. The
ministries and missions of this church
have impacted thousands upon
thousands of lives, all done for the
glory of God. Now, it is time for us to
help put LTUMC on the path that God
has set for us for the next 36 years
and beyond.

In this new season, we know we are being called to new ministries, new areas of our community, and new connections with our neighbors. These Christ-centered connections will not only continue to be Kingdombuilding efforts, but they will also be part of building the next generation of disciples that will carry LTUMC far into the future.

ENVISION... a debt-free church that invests an extra \$21,000 per month — EVERY MONTH — in our ministries, community, and people. How can we be more effective in growing our youth and children's ministries and our commitment to feeding those who are hungry? How can we extend our missional reach, further support our educators, and share God's unconditional love with those who





have never experienced it? Consider ways we can enhance our online and social media presence utilizing the latest technology, improve our playground area to make it more inviting and kid-friendly, or allocate additional resources to support our community's mental wellness. As we know, with God, the possibilities are endless.

WHY DEBT, WHY NOW?

When our Ministry Activities Center was completed, we had \$3.5 million in outstanding debt. We've been diligently paying it off and have made great strides. Our current debt is now just below \$2 million. When we refinanced five years ago, the interest rate was a favorable 4.15%, but it resets every five years, and in March 2026, we're facing what looks like a minimum increase to 6%.

This means our current payment on that debt, which is \$17,560 per month,

will grow to at least \$21,560, representing an increase of almost \$4,000 per month or \$48,000 per year! That amount is unsustainable if we want to continue being effective in sustaining and growing our ministries.

In order to maintain our current payment level, we must reduce our loan balance to at least \$1.5 million. However, we're aiming even higher because we believe God has great plans for the resources He has blessed us with.

Over the next three years, we hope to entirely eliminate our debt so that more of your generous contributions can grow the impact of LTUMC's life-changing ministries, support the staff, and extend our church's outreach. In other words, we want to turn our annual mortgage payments of approximately \$260,000 per year into ministry and mission! \$\circ\$

FAQs

Who decided to move forward with this campaign?

Our Finance Team and Leadership Team unanimously recommended and approved we undergo this campaign.

Where will money go and who decides how it is spent?

Money saved over time will be invested in growing our church through our children, youth, adult, missions and music programs, as well as staff care and campus maintenance. Our Finance Team, in collaboration with our Church Council, will prioritize how theses funds are redirected as they are available.

How is this different from our regular tithing/giving?

Your regular giving funds the general budget, which allows us to operate the church

The *Free to Rise* campaign reduces debt on our building loan in order to grow our ministry potential. We ask your *Free to Rise* gift be a gift beyond your annual stewardship pledge, not as a substitute.

What happens if we don't raise all the money?

No matter how much we raise, it will reduce our mortgage principal, and significantly lower our principal and interest payments going forward.

What are the financial expectations of the congregation?

Every household in our congregation is invited to pray, "God, what do You want to do through me?" As we each pray, discern and commit our individual part, our collected sacrifice will fulfill this campaign vision. Gift size will vary numerically by household, according to financial situation, and God's guidance.

How will commitments be requested?

A commitment card will be mailed the week of Nov 10, and you are asked to respond by Commitment Sunday, Nov 16, offering your three-year sacrificial gift.
