Assist the Lead Teacher, Senior, and Junior Counselor with the following:

- · Active outdoor play: animal encounters, waterplay, science experiments, crafts, and hiking
- Helping Senior and Junior Counselors with classroom setup
- Cleaning tables and putting away supplies and materials
- Get to know the campers, and provide a fun, safe, and welcoming environment
- Greeting children with enthusiasm during arrival
- Take direction from the lead teacher and senior counselor
- Report any concerns to the lead teacher or camp director

Requirements:

- Appreciation and respect towards animals and nature
- Patient, understanding, and kind to children 4 10 years of age
- Ability to work as a team
- Demonstrate creativity and enthusiasm
- Self-motivated, upbeat, and high energy
- Punctual and dependable
