Responsibilities:

Assist your team members with:

- Activities based on curriculum, activities may include animal encounters, waterplay, science experiments, crafts and hiking
- Supervise and interact with children at all times
- Help clean tables and putting away supplies and materials
- Work under the direction of the lead teacher and senior counselor
- Get to know your campers, provide a positive, supportive and welcoming environment
- Positive interactions with parents and staff
- Participate in an orderly drop-off and dismissal and greet children with enthusiasm
- Review lesson plan and gather supplies the day prior to teaching the lesson

Requirements:

- Appreciation and respect towards animals and nature
- Patient, understanding, and kind to young children 4 to 10 years of age
- Being able to multi-task and stay calm in stressful circumstances
- Ability to lift about 40 pounds (camp supplies, children, animal enclosures)
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Demonstrate leadership abilities and creativity
- Self-motivated, upbeat, and high energy
- Punctual and dependable
