### **LEAD TEACHER/NATURE EDUCATOR JOB DESCRIPTION**

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Work with camp counselors to prepare and lead daily activities based on the provided curriculum
- Responsible for the safety of campers at all times
- Know and follow all safety protocols
- Gather and utilize available materials, artifacts, and live animals to enhance lessons
- Be an engaged teacher, listen to your campers, and provide a fun, supportive, and welcoming environment
- Convey love and respect for the natural world
- Be willing to get dirty, handle animals, and engage deeply in nature
- Set up and break down tents and supplies each day
- Have positive interactions with parents and staff
- Lead an orderly and enthusiastic drop-off and dismissal
- Report to the Camp Director any concerns or challenges related to your class in a timely manner
- Keep all materials organized and clean
- Provide guidance and support to your junior and senior counselors
- Review the lesson plan and gather supplies prior to teaching the lesson

- Appreciation and respect towards animals and nature
- Enjoy spending time and interacting with young children 4 - 10 years of age
- Being able to multi-task and stay calm in stressful circumstances
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds (camp supplies, children, animal enclosures)
- Demonstrate leadership abilities and creativity
- Self-motivated, punctual, and dependable
- Complete criminal background check in accordance with State Licensing
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Provide documentation of a current health exam
