

Dorothy and K.D. Kennedy Endowed Camp Scholarship

This camp scholarship has been established through a gift from the estate of K.D. Kennedy.

A native of LaGrange, K.D. served as Council President for the East Carolina Council, was awarded the Silver Beaver and attended the National Jamboree. Scouting was close to K.D.'s heart and he often recited the Philmont grace as words to live by.

Eligibility: Camp scholarships are open to any Scout who is registered in the East Carolina Council. Scholarships are available to cover part of the cost of Cub Scout day camp, Cub Scout resident camp, Webelos camp, Camp Bonner or the Pamlico Sea Base.

Specifics: Camp scholarships will be awarded based upon the financial need of the applicants and their Scouting involvement. The amount awarded to an applicant will be determined contingent upon the funds available and the number of applications received. The amount of the scholarship will not exceed the registration cost of the program and it will be deducted from the amount the applicant will pay to attend a program.

Deadline: Applications are due by April 1 of each year and decisions will be made by May 1. The East Carolina Council asks that all recipients submit a thank you note to be forwarded to the Kennedy family.
