- A. **4-H Beef Show Attire** – Jean pants with a solid, collared, button down or polo shirt. No ripped jeans or patterned shirts.
- B. All animals exhibited must have halters and neck ropes.
- C. Show is open to all NH and VT 4-H beef exhibitors.
- D. Exhibitors will be limited to one animal per class within a single breed. Exhibitors may exhibit more than one breed.
- E. All breeds will be judged separately.
- F. Animals for all classes may be commercial or registered. Breed should be noted on entry. Registration papers will be checked.
- G. Feeder and Market animals do not need to be registered.

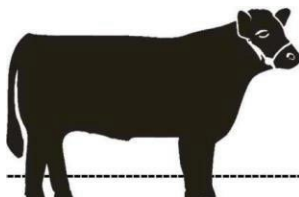

1. SENIOR FITTING AND SHOWMANSHIP for members 14 years old or older on January 1.
2. INTERMEDIATE FITTING & SHOWMANSHIP for members 12-13 years old January 1.
3. JUNIOR FITTING AND SHOWMANSHIP for members 9-11 years old January 1.
4. NOVICE FITTING AND SHOWMANSHIP first time showing under 14 years of age.
5. Overall Showmanship Champion – Special Award
6. JUNIOR BULL CALF born after January 1 - April 30, 2026.
7. SENIOR BULL CALF born after Sept. 1 - December 31, 2025.
8. CHAMPION BULL first place winners from Classes 4 and 5 - **Rosette**.
9. JUNIOR HEIFER CALF born after January 1 - April 30, 2026.
10. SENIOR HEIFER CALF born September 1 - December 31, 2025.
11. SUMMER YEARLING HEIFER May 1 - August 31, 2025.
12. JUNIOR YEARLING HEIFER January 1 - April 30, 2025.
13. SENIOR YEARLING HEIFER September 1 - December 31, 2024.
14. TWO YEAR OLD HEIFER September 1, 2020 to August 31, 2024.
15. THREE YEAR OLD COW OR OLDER born September 1, 2023 or earlier. (Note in classes 14 & 15: calves can be shown at side with cow or in individual classes.)
16. CHAMPION FEMALE (first places in classes 8-14) **Rosette**
17. SUPREME CHAMPION **Trophy Award**
18. FEEDER ANIMAL (steer or heifer) September 1, 2024 to April 30, 2026.
19. MARKET ANIMAL (steer or heifer) January 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025.
20. CHAMPION MARKET ANIMAL **Special Award**
21. PAIR OF CALVES (Heifers or Bull or one of each.) Animals shown in this class must have been shown in individual classes.
22. PAIR OF YEARLING HEIFERS (Heifers only.) Animals shown in this class must have been shown in individual classes.
23. PROMOTION OF AGRICULTURE AWARD – Danish System of awards will be used. *Each member will be judged on the youth exhibitor's: availability to educate and interact with the public, willingness to share information and answer questions as an overall promoter of agriculture. Credit will also be given for more experienced members being available to younger members in need of guidance.*

- A certificate of liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$300,000 is required of beef, dairy, and horse exhibitors.
- 4-H members shall show respect for the property and facilities used during the fair and will assume financial responsibility for any damage they cause.
- 4-H members shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner that is appropriate and respectful of themselves and others.
- 4-H members shall not use nor possess alcoholic beverages nor controlled drugs.
- All the animals we plan to exhibit at Cornish Fair have been vaccinated for rabies.
- All 4-H members' animals are shown at the risk of the owner or lessor.
- Any damage to persons or property are the legal and financial responsibility of the 4-H member who owns or leases the animal and their family.

I/We have read and discussed the above expectations and hereby agree to accept them. I/We have read and understand the basic 4-H rules and rules pertaining to the Animal Shows we are involved with, in the 4-H Cornish Fair Book. I/We understand that failure to comply shall result in the 4-H member being expelled from the fair and premiums will be withheld.

We give permission for the above named youth to participate and, by our signature, take full responsibility for his/her actions. We understand the responsibilities, hazards, and dangers inherent in participation in this activity, including the transportation. We understand the Code of Conduct.
