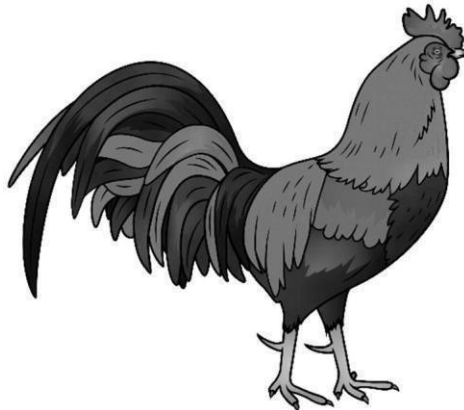


4-H Poultry Show

- A. Poultry show open to NH youth poultry exhibitors. There may be space limitations for entries. Sullivan County entries will be given first priority, entries from other counties will be accepted on a first come first serve basis until full.
- B. All animals must have legible leg bands, which must appear on the 4-H approval form, lease form and State Vet test results under that identification. Animals must be in proper physical condition and free of visual evidence of infection, contagious or parasitic diseases at the time of arrival or will be barred from the show. All animals will be inspected prior to being penned.
- C. All animals must meet all of the current NH Dept. of Agriculture regulations.
- D. All exhibitors must participate in Fitting & Showmanship Class.
- E. Each exhibitor is allowed up to three (3) entries.
- F. Exhibitors are responsible for take-down of the cages they use, care of their animals and neatness of the entire exhibit area all 3 days on the fairgrounds. Those members not complying will forfeit premiums.
- G. Cages: Standard cages will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Members must provide animals bedding, feed, and water. Please bring containers for feed and water.
- H. Animals for sale: Members may have animals for sale ONLY IF they have made arrangements with the Superintendent in advance. These animals must be healthy and meet health requirements, including leg bands and NH testing.
- I. The Danish System of awards will be used.

- J. Fitting & Showing Premiums
 - A. 30.00 B. 25.00 C. 20.00

CLASSES

- 1. Fitting and Showmanship – Judged on condition of animal, handling, knowledge of care and feeding.
 - a. Seniors – age 14-18 as of January 1.
 - b. Intermediate – age 12-13 as of January 1.
 - c. Juniors – age 9-11 as of January 1.
 - d. Novice – age 8-11 or members in their first year of showing poultry.

- A certificate of liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$300,000 is required of beef, dairy, and horse exhibitors.
- 4-H members shall show respect for the property and facilities used during the fair and will assume financial responsibility for any damage they cause.
- 4-H members shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner that is appropriate and respectful of themselves and others.
- 4-H members shall not use nor possess alcoholic beverages nor controlled drugs.
- All the animals we plan to exhibit at Cornish Fair have been vaccinated for rabies.
- All 4-H members' animals are shown at the risk of the owner or lessor.
- Any damage to persons or property are the legal and financial responsibility of the 4-H member who owns or leases the animal and their family.

I/We have read and discussed the above expectations and hereby agree to accept them. I/We have read and understand the basic 4-H rules and rules pertaining to the Animal Shows we are involved with, in the 4-H Cornish Fair Book. I/We understand that failure to comply shall result in the 4-H member being expelled from the fair and premiums will be withheld.

We give permission for the above named youth to participate and, by our signature, take full responsibility for his/her actions. We understand the responsibilities, hazards, and dangers inherent in participation in this activity, including the transportation. We understand the Code of Conduct.

We hold harmless the Cornish Fair Association, its trustees, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from and against all claims, demands, actions, and causes of action for damages which may be sustained by the above named youth or anyone else. This includes personal injury, death, or property damage, whether or not the result of negligent acts or omissions. If the above named youth's participation in the activity causes damage to property, we agree to pay for such loss.
