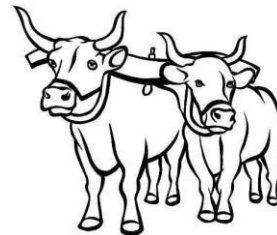
B. Exhibitors may only show one team at the fair.

CLASSES

Fitting and Showmanship: Condition and appearance of team, equipment, and teamster's knowledge of the project will be considered.

1. Senior Teamster – 14-18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.

2. Junior Teamster – 9-13 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.

3. Novice Teamster – 8-13 years of age as of January 1 of the current year and showing for the first time.

4. Working Steer Cart Class – Ability of team and teamster to hitch to, and maneuver with, a two wheeled cart, as directed by the judge; time will be considered.

5. Working Steer Stoneboat Performance – Teams must pull a dead weight, negotiate an obstacle course demonstrating the ability of the team to work, and the teamster's ability to drive their team. Time and course at the discretion of the judge.

6. Single Steer – Best condition and confirmation of single.

7. Working Steer Best Matched Team – Markings, condition, and conformation of pair will be considered.

8. Working Steer Best Trained Team – Best trained pair, evaluated on response to teamster's commands as directed by the judge.

9. PROMOTION OF AGRICULTURE AWARD – Danish System of awards will be used. Each member will be judged on the youth exhibitor's: availability to educate and interact with the public, willingness to share information and answer questions as an overall promoter of agriculture. Credit will also be given for more experienced members being available to younger members in need of guidance.

- A certificate of liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$300,000 is required of beef, dairy, and horse exhibitors.
- 4-H members shall show respect for the property and facilities used during the fair and will assume financial responsibility for any damage they cause.
- 4-H members shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner that is appropriate and respectful of themselves and others.
- 4-H members shall not use nor possess alcoholic beverages nor controlled drugs.
- All the animals we plan to exhibit at Cornish Fair have been vaccinated for rabies.
- All 4-H members' animals are shown at the risk of the owner or lessor.
- Any damage to persons or property are the legal and financial responsibility of the 4-H member who owns or leases the animal and their family.

I/We have read and discussed the above expectations and hereby agree to accept them. I/We have read and understand the basic 4-H rules and rules pertaining to the Animal Shows we are involved with, in the 4-H Cornish Fair Book. I/We understand that failure to comply shall result in the 4-H member being expelled from the fair and premiums will be withheld.

We give permission for the above named youth to participate and, by our signature, take full responsibility for his/her actions. We understand the responsibilities, hazards, and dangers inherent in participation in this activity, including the transportation. We understand the Code of Conduct.

We hold harmless the Cornish Fair Association, its trustees, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from and against all claims, demands, actions, and causes of action for damages which may be sustained by the above named youth or anyone else.
