Community Recreation: To provide a space for recreation and social interactions. Serving as a venue for events, gatherings and activities that enrich the community and enhance its cultural life.

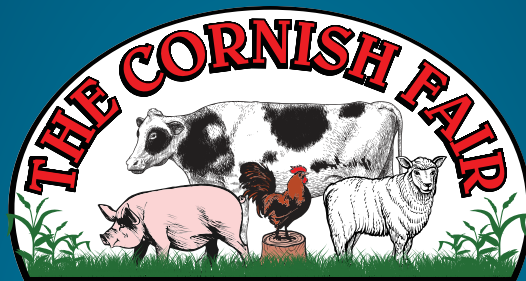

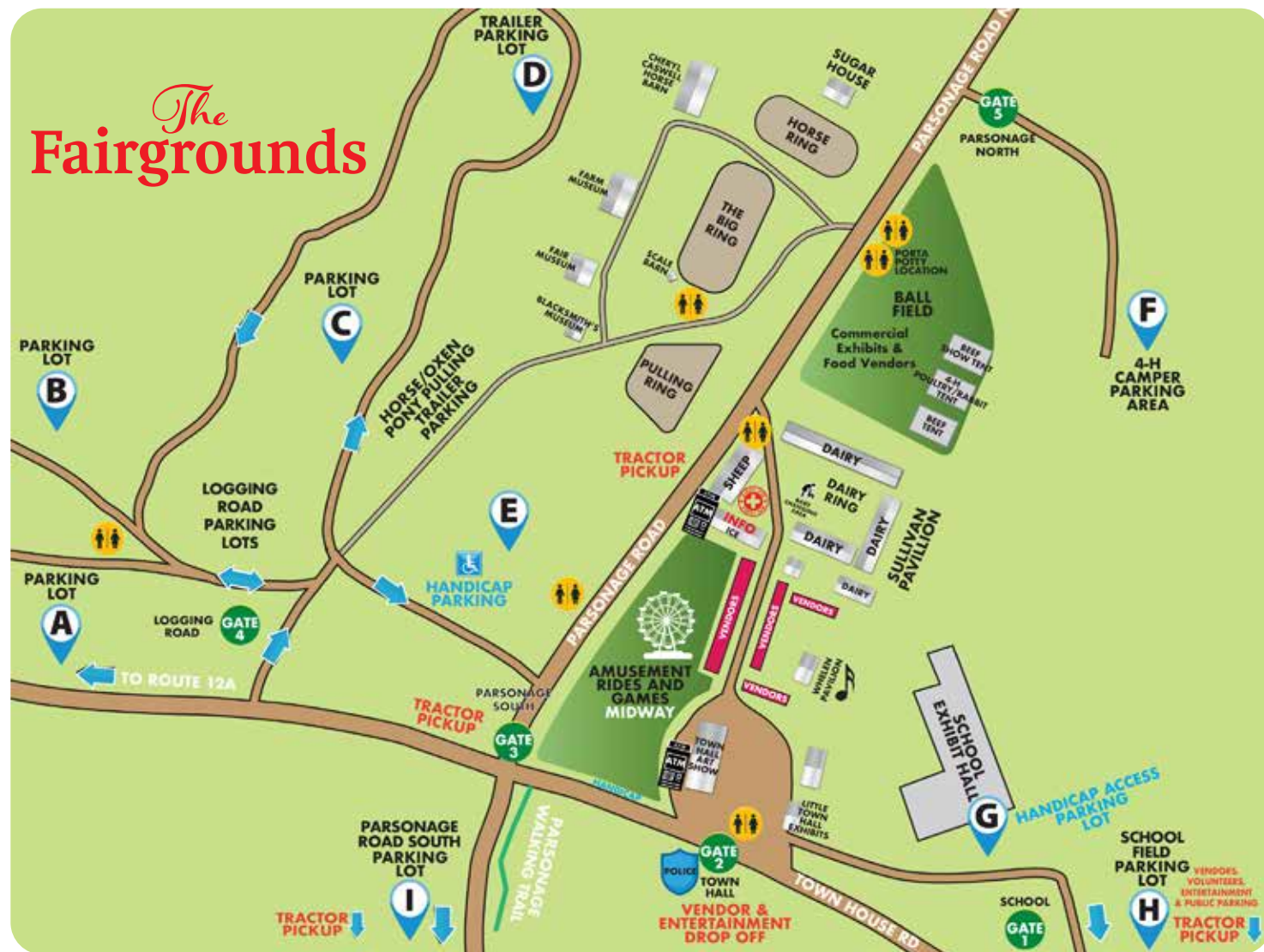
Below Deck
