Contest Rules:

1. The Cornish Fair Prince & Princess Contest is open to all children between the ages of 7 and 12 at the time of the fair. There are no residency requirements for entrance.
2. Each contestant must complete an application and submit a recent photo:
 - a. Applications can be found on the website at www.cornishfairnh.org or by emailing the Pageant or Entertainment Directors for a copy.
 - b. Application and photo must be received by Wednesday, August 5th, 2026, at midnight for consideration.
 - c. Each applicant must be available for a sit-down interview with the judging panel on Friday, August 21st, 2026, at the fair. (*Interview Times are TBD and will be communicated prior to the event.*)
3. Judging will be based on the sit-down interview with the judges. Judges will be looking for a contestant who displays the following:
 - a. Passion for the fair
 - b. Is hard-working
 - c. Demonstrates community involvement
 - d. Is overall a well-rounded individual
4. Interview Scoring
 - a. Communication (75%)
 - b. Presentation (25%) – the manner in which the contestants present themselves for the interview (attire.)
 - i. Attire may be play, school, or dress clothing
5. The judge's decision is final. In the event of a tie, the judges will decide a winner.
6. The Prince and Princess will be crowned Friday afternoon at the Fair.
7. Contestants should arrive at the stage in dress attire for the crowning by 2:30PM.
8. Based on the afternoon interview score, a winner will be chosen and crowned as Cornish Fair Princess and Prince. Runners-up will be announced, and prizes will be decided based on the number of entries.
9. Winners will receive a trophy, gifts donated by local merchants.

Contest Rules:

1. The Cornish Fair King & Queen Contest is open to youth between the ages of 13 and 22 years of age at the time of the fair. There are no residency requirements for entrance.
2. Each contestant must complete an application and submit a recent photo:
 - a. Applications can be found on the website at www.cornishfairnh.org or by emailing the Pageant or Entertainment Directors for a copy.
 - b. Each contestant is required to find sponsors who will contribute a minimum of \$50.00. Contestants may raise more funds, but not less.
 - c. Each applicant must be available for a sit-down interview with the judging panel on Friday, August 21st, 2026, at the fair. *(Interview Times are TBD and will be communicated prior to the event.)*
 - d. Application and photo can be emailed or submitted in person to the pageant director, but they must be received by the beginning of the first rehearsal on Saturday, August 8th, 2026. *(Time TBA)*
 - e. All contestants will be required to wear their sashes and be visible to the public throughout the duration of the fair.
3. Judging will be based upon the following criteria:
 - a. Interview: (30%) – Judges will be evaluating character, leadership and personality
 - b. Talent: (30%) – Contestants may exhibit a talent of their choosing. Exhibit may be no longer than 3 minutes per contestant.
 - c. Formal Wear: (30%) – Evaluation of poise and sense of style
 - d. Overall Presentation: (10%)
 - i. In case of a tie, judges make the final decision
4. The judge's decision is final. In the event of a tie, the judges will decide a winner.
5. The King and Queen will be crowned Friday afternoon at the Fair.
6. Prizes:
 - a. King & Queen will receive a crown (for the reigning year), trophy donated by the Boardman family in memory of Hollis Boardman, Sr., a bouquet and the Cornish Fair sash.
 - b. 1st Runner Up will receive a trophy and sash
 - c. 2nd Runner Up will receive a trophy and sash
 - d. Talent winner will receive a trophy and sash
 - e. Miss Congeniality will be chosen by a vote of the contestants and receive a trophy and sash
 - f. Cash prizes will be awarded; the amounts will be determined by the number of contestants
 - g. All contestants will receive flowers and a certificate
