Arusha

Days 1-2

**Karibu Tanzania!
Let the adventure begin!**

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you'll be met by your Wilderness Legends guide who will transfer you to your accommodation.



Your second day will be spent exploring beautiful Arusha National Park for the first game drive of your safari.

Zebras, giraffes, baboons, buffalo, colobus and blue monkeys, and many beautiful birds inhabit this lush sanctuary and stunning landscape. Around Momella Lake you may see hippos and flamingos. Beautiful crowned cranes live here, too, along with hundreds of other fascinating bird species.

Tarangire National Park

Day 3 and 4



Today we head to Tarangire National Park. This park is well known for its elephant families, which are often seen congregating by the river and finding shade under the baobab trees dotted throughout the park.



Giraffe are prolific throughout the park, and you may also see impala, bushbuck, eland, hartebeest, buffalo and more. These animals are closely followed by predators like lion, cheetah and leopard. There are also more breeding species of birds found in Tarangire National Park than anywhere else on the planet!



Karatu

Days 5-6



Your two days in the Karatu region will include cultural visits to experience the Maasai, Hadzabe and/or Datoga tribes and learning about their cultures and lifestyles.

A visit to the village of Mto wa Mbu will also give you a glimpse of Tanzanian life that many people do not get to see, along with a potential visit to Manyara National Park, time permitting.

Shopping at African Galleria while enroute to Karatu will be included, and an optional visit to a local coffee farm can be arranged for those that would like to see firsthand how coffee is grown and produced.



Ngorongoro Crater and Ndutu

Days 7 and 8



Today starts with an early departure as we work our way through the forest, to the Ngorongoro Crater. Descend to the crater floor, a breathtaking experience, and spend the morning in this beautiful environment.



Considered to be the Garden of Eden of Africa, this dramatic caldera is inhabited by more than 25,000 resident animals and inhabited by the Big Five (including the endangered black rhino!) as well as zebra, hippo, wildebeest, cheetah, and so much more. Continue on to Ndutu for your next two nights.



Ndutu



Enjoy beautiful game drives in the Ndutu Area exploring a range of habitats. One of the prime game viewing spots is around Lake Ndutu, where enormous herds of wildebeest congregate between December and April to graze and calve.

The forests and granite kopjes around the lake are also home to a variety of wildlife outside of the migration months, making for prime game viewing throughout the year.

Enjoy sundowners around the campfire at this beautiful lodge, where the wildlife is often part of the view from your chairs!



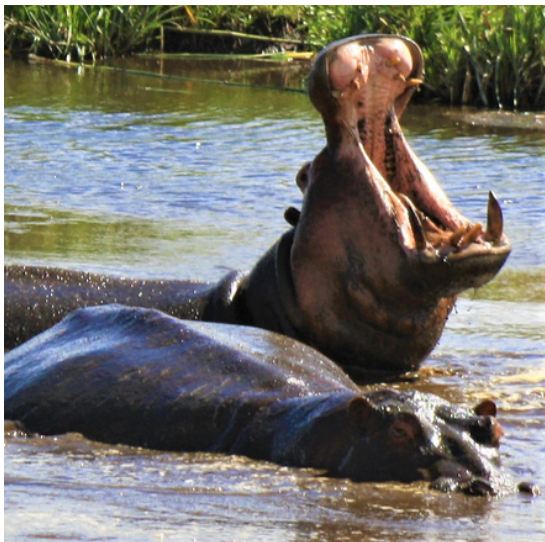
And by now you'll be acquainted with the resident genets who keep a watchful eye on your dinner from the rafters above - a very unique trademark of this special camp!

Serengeti

Days 9-10



Today you'll have a game drive while enroute to this iconic park from the Ndotu region. Several days in the Serengeti will then be spent viewing the beautiful wildlife, especially cat sightings and possibly some hunts.



Herds of wildebeest, zebra, many types of antelopes, elephant, hippos and crocs are just some of what you'll see while on your game drives, along with spectacular bird sightings.



Arusha

Days 11-13



After breakfast, you'll head to the Seronera Airstrip for your flight back to Arusha. Our drivers will pick you up and transport you to your next accommodation in the Kilimanjaro region.

Enjoy unwinding for the next few days at the Kilimanjaro Coffee Lodge, where you can take nature walks, have a coffee and tea farm tour, relax at their pool, or enjoy a bit of pampering at their spa - a wonderful few days to relax and reflect before your onward journey.

Your last day will include our annual visit to the Kilimanjaro Christian Medical Centre, with a special focus on the Cancer Care Centre. This will include a personal tour led by Dr. Furaha Serventi, Head of Oncology and the Centre's director. See first-hand the remarkable facilities and meet the wonderful staff who provide care for cancer patients. This tour will also include a special presentation on the progress of cancer care in northern Tanzania.



As this day concludes it will mark the end of your safari holiday with Wilderness Legends. Transport will be provided to the Kilimanjaro International Airport for you to connect with your onward journey.

- 44-30 days before the scheduled arrival date: 50% of the tour price will be charged.
- 29 days or less before the scheduled arrival date: 100% of the total tour price will be charged.
