## **Process description:**

Ruby grain is a ready-to-use rodenticide bait containing 0.005% difenacoum. It is used for controlling brown rats, black rats and house mice. The product is to be used in and around buildings, in burrows (around the outdoor use around buildings).

## **Application:**

Brown rat infestations: Low infestations - use bait points of 90-100g placed 10m apart

High infestations – use bait points of 90-100g placed 5m apart

**Black rat infestations:** Low infestations – use bait points of 90-100g placed 10m apart

High infestations – use bait points of 90-100g placed 5m apart

House mouse infestations: Low infestations - use bait points of 20-30 g placed 5m apart

High infestations – use bait points of 20-30g of 3m in high infestations.

**In Burrows** 90-100g per burrow

Baits should be securely deposited to minimize the risk of consumption by non-target animals and should be placed in bait stations or other covered bait points.
