Process description:

Carefully cut off top of tube using a knife.

Fix nozzle to the tube and screw on tightly. If required, carefully trim the nozzle to give a thicker application of sealant.

Apply sealant with caulking gun, make sure the layer depth of sealant is at least 15mm and the gap is completely filled to the edges on all sides.

Smooth the applied sealant with a pallet knife or equivalent tool for a smooth finish.
