The Eastern Negro League (ENL) also had a Southern Division that included the following teams: Danville Stars, Durham Eagles, Hopewell Stars, Kinston Greys, Lynchburg Colored Cardinals, Richmond Giants and Winston-Salem Pond Giants.

The Harrisburg Giants were awarded the Doc Marshall Memorial Trophy and crowned the champions of the 1954 Eastern Negro League season.

Tom Hailey of the Harrisburg Giants won league's Most Valuable Player (MVP) award.
