

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.091200 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Williamson Emergency Services District #8.

PROPOSED TAX RATE: \$0.091200 per \$100

NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE: \$0.091200 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE: \$0.094689 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Williamson Emergency Services District #8 from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Williamson Emergency Services District #8 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Williamson Emergency Services District #8 is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON 09/10/2025 06:00 PM at Fire Station 6, 6700 RM 2338, Georgetown, TX.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Williamson Emergency Services District #8 is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the governing body of Williamson Emergency Services District #8 at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
