Call to order

ISDA- The Director informed the Board that Hailey Kane has been hired as the new Resource Specialist. Her assigned counties include Vigo, Clay, Parke, and Vermillion.

Steven informed the Board that outreach and promotion for the 2026–2027 Free Tree Giveaway program will begin on Monday, June 15. The five-tree species being offered this year are White Pine, Bur Oak, Persimmon, Shagbark Hickory, and Redbud. In the event that any of these species become unavailable, substitute species will include Red Pine, Swamp White Oak, Shellbark Hickory, American Plum, and Silky Dogwood.

The Board discussed options for the distribution of tree tubes, including providing up to five tree tubes free of charge and charging for any additional tubes, or implementing a fee for all tree tubes distributed.

The Director provided an update to the Board regarding the Herman White Boat Launch project and its current status.

New business- The Director informed the Board that the Local Lead Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 11, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. and will be held prior to the regularly scheduled Board Meeting at 6:00 p.m.

The Director said he is still working on setting up a Water Education event. As discussed at the May meeting, this was also mentioned to the two guests who were in attendance. He is looking for a speaker who can talk about water quantity and water availability. More information will be shared as plans come together.

Other New Business:

Joel Wesch's River Friendly Farmer nomination was submitted.

The State Soil Conservation Board has hired a firm to do a Comprehensive Needs Assessment for all 92 counties. They are looking at how Clean Indiana Water funds are being spent and how districts could better use those funds. They will be at the office on August 26th to talk with staff about what the office does. They are basically trying to get a look at district offices from one end of the state to the other.

The Director mentioned to the board that he has two meetings set up. One is with the Jordan Creek SWCD group to talk about moving forward with the Jordan Creek planning application. The Notice of Intent (NOI) was submitted to IDEM.

The second meeting is with engineers and design folks from the Vermillion Rise Solar Project. They want to go over what the project will look like and how to make sure the application is done correctly the first time when submitting.
