Welcome to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Celebration. This year we are happy to enjoy our 100th year. A lot has happened in that time and we would like to share some of our memories with you. It all started with a small group of immigrants (most of them from Gesso, Italy) who wanted to give thanks to Our Lady for safe arrival here and for special favors. The year was 1875. The house was located at 232 Pine Road and the family who resided there was the Antonio Capelli's. A picture of the Virgin was hung in the home. The immigrants knelt and prayed in front of this, then formed a small procession in front of the home. So it began, in a small way, to be one of the largest celebrations of its kind, attracting thousands of visitors every year. Members of the group who originated the holiday were Luigi Vuotto, Cataldo Vuotto, Emanuel Persico, Pepino Persico, Don Joseph, Antonio Scapocchia, Pietro Luca, Santa D'Agostino, Matteo Campanella, Domenic Campanella, Anthony Lupo and Salvatore Calabrese. In 1905 the Mt. Carmel Society became a chartered organization. Following is their progress for the century.

1875 - 1885

First reports of the Festival in "The Republican" was July 26, 1884. The story said many people attended the celebration. Peanut stands, fruit stands and lemonade stands were the highlights. Fireworks were held at Main Rd. school house.

1886

This year the celebration was moved to the Hammonton Lake Park. Besides the stands and fireworks, two bands from Philadelphia entertained.

1887

The Mt. Carmel Society paraded in the morning with their new American and Italian flags. An excellent band entertained and many visitors from the city were here. For the first time, mass was at St. Joseph's Church. After mass and procession, a good crowd gathered at the Park to witness a fireworks exhibition.

1891

A life - sized statue of "Our Lady of Mt. Carmel" was presented to St. Joseph's Church by a congregation headed by Domenica De Leo which was blessed at the Festival on the 16th by Reverend Father Isoleri of Philadelphia.

1892

A good time was had by the Italians on "Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Day." In answer to many inquiries, according to tradition, Mary, the mother of Jesus, was an inmate of the convent on Mt. Carmel, the historic mountain in Palestine, hence the title given above. A parade was held and mass was heard at St. Joseph's. In the evening fireworks and music attracted many people. Although noisy, the affair was orderly, so stated "The Republican."

1894

On this day, mass was sung by Rev. A. Van Reil and sermon was given by Rev. G. Baudinelli, Passionist Provincial. The highlight of the celebration was a statue presented to the church of St. Anthony, which was blessed by Fr. Baudinelli. Many people carried candles in the procession.

1895

A crowd of 500 joined in the celebration which was led by the 32-piece Columbia military band from Philadelphia. Mass was said by Bishop McFaul. A crowd of almost 3,000 witnessed the fireworks that evening.

1896

The feast proved to be getting larger this year. More people participated and the Jefferson Coronet Band of Philadelphia supplied the music. The procession stopped from time to time as people held devotional exercises. No matter how prejudiced the spectator was he could not help notice the earnestness and ferver attending these public ceremonies. The festivities were called "The Italian Fourth of July."

1897

People came from all around to participate in the festival. These are one of the happiest people on earth and they certainly had a good time today. Americans enjoyed it as well as Italians.

1900

A crowd of 1000 joined in the celebration this year. Music was furnished by St. Cecelia's band from Philadelphia. Procession passed through town at 9 P. M., then back to church and the Italian Society Hall. Fireworks highlighted the evening.

1901

This year was filled with incidents. As the time the procession was to begin, Father Rohleder forbade the men to remove the statues from the church. The crowd jammed inside the church and the priest had to call for police assistance and many people were hurt. Finally the priest came outside and gave a lengthy sermon which seemed to quiet down the crowd and there was no further trouble. Later that evening, a piece of firework went astray and landed in a box containing rockets setting them off in all directions. Fortunately no one was hurt. The evening ended with a thunderstorm.

1902

Mass was said this year by a young priest, Fr. Joseph Cirinconi from New York. "The Virgin" was loaded with gifts from the crowd including watches, jewelry and chains of bills. The attraction of the day was the fireworks display on Mr. Walther's field.

1905

This year was claimed as a record-breaking year for the celebration. Throngs of people came from all around and three bands participated in the procession. A party from Philadelphia erected a screen near the grandstand and gave a free exhibition of moving pictures, mostly taken from the Passion Play. Two thousand people watched a fireworks display that lasted 1½ hours. It was described as rare and beautiful. To the town in general, it was a holiday.













The pictures above were taken in the year 1938 as the procession was winding its way down Egg Harbor Road. The priest shown in the photos leading the procession is the ever popular Rev. Lucien Abbate.

1906

Again the chowds were immense as the Italians had another successful Again the crowds were immense as the Italians had another successful cream and lemonade stands helped give the day a "Country Fair" atmosphere. Movies were shown again at night and the fireworks display was beautiful.

1907-1908-1909

These three years were all successful as the procession grew larger. Crowds were estimated at well near 5,000. A dance pavillion and a trapeze act plus the usual fireworks added to the evenings' entertainment.

1910-1911

Hammonton was a very populous and lively town on this day as scores of people came from all points to join in the festivities. A fine merry-goround and ocean wave, the monkey and organ man, bagpipes and other miscellaneous instruments delighted the crowd. The procession took the usual route and held the interest of everyone. Arches of brightly-colored lamps lined Bellevue Ave. and Third St. Three bands filled the air with music.

1913

A definite success as an estimated 10,000 people jammed into town to witness the celebration. An accident the following day did mar the events though. Giovanni Romano, who furnished the fireworks display, was badly maimed and probably blinded as some unused bombs exploded while he was packing them. Dr. Butler was called, but sent him immediately to Pennsylvania Hospital.

1915

The town was awakened by a "surprise salute" at 7 A. M. that was fired to start the day's activities. At 8:30, a band accompanied by some of the society men paraded the streets and pleased the people with a few concerts. Later the town was greeted with an influx of humanity and the celebration lasted well past midnight. The grand procession included three bands and five statues each with garlands of bills offered by the faithful. Third St. was lined for several blocks on both sides with all kinds of booths. Colored electric lights made the street beautiful. A three-day carnival drew considerable interest. It is hoped the spiritual condition of the participants was improved.

1917-1918

The war years had much to do with the size of the crowds during the feast, but it went on as usual and was considered successful despite the hard times.

1919-1923

No records could be located for these years.

1924-1926

The feast day has grown in proportions as more than 20,000 people enjoyed the festivities. The grand procession started at 4:30 P. M. from St. Joe with a grand display of fireworks at 10 P. M. A Venetian electric light display was also shown.

1928-1930

The religious Fiesta brought a large influx of people to Hammonton to enjoy the day's program. The crowds were handled well by local and state police.

1931-1933

The celebration these years was headed by Fr. Guido Steccati, pastor of St. Joseph's Church and his assistant Fr. Marino. The long and colorful procession left St. Joe Church at 4 P.M. accompanied by two bands. Although these were depression years, the crowds continued to grow. The firemen sponsored the week-long carnival which featured for the first time professional boxing.

1934

Crowds estimated at 40,000 attended the celebration this year according to Joseph Pizzi, head of the Mt. Carmel organization. The carnival this year featured many new rides and shows including the Motor Drome. The festivities were highlighted by a gala fireworks display and a dance held at St. Joe auditorium with music by the "Nite Revelers."

1935

The usual throng of 40,000 people invaded Hammonton to honor "Our Lady" this year. The procession was led by Mayor Wesley E. Vaughn, P. Anthony Colasurdo and Joseph Pizzi. West's World Wonder Shows played all week for the pleasure of the people. A colorful fireworks display ended the festivities at midnight.

1936-1937

These two years showed a marked increase in the crowds coming to Hammonton as pilgrims from five different states came to join the celebration. The Endy Bros. carnival featured rides never seen before in the South Jersey area.

1938

The Rev. Lucien Abbate officiated the special services at the church this year as over 50,000 people jammed into Hammonton. Congressman Elmer Wene led the procession. The local John Raffa band and the VFW band from Camden supplied the music. Catlen and Wilson shows played at the carnival grounds all week.

1939-1940-1941

These years were all a repeat performance of the year before as throngs of people came to worship "Our Lady." The famed Zacchini Brothers played at the fairgrounds for the week.

1942-1945

The war years brought many people here for the procession even though gas rationing took its toll. Also missing were the carnival and fireworks due to wartime restrictions.

1946

The first year after the war saw the crowds swell again to an estimated 40,000 people to give thanks to "Our Lady." Prell shows supplied the entertainment featuring a 110 - foot high dive act.



1947-1948-1949

One hundred special buses transported some of the estimated 50,000 here for the celebration. Five bands joined the procession led by Fr. Mark Martorelli. A new Chevrolet was raffled off the evening of the celebration.

1950

This was the 75th anniversary of the celebration and the crowds exceeded 50,000. The Mt. Carmel Society honored its founders on this day. Six masses were held at St. Joseph's followed by a mammoth procession which was led by Sen. Elmer Wene.

1951-1952-1953

Many faithful continued their journey here on this day as the celebration became known throughout the East.

1954

This was the 79th year of our celebration and also Marian Year. Fr. Rinaldi invited Catholics from all over to celebrate here. The procession was huge including three bands. The K of C sponsored a dance at St. Joe school featuring music by the "Nomads." Since the feast fell on Friday, Bishop Eustace of Camden gave special dispensation to all Catholics in the vicinity of Hammonton to eat meat. The evening closed with a grand display of fireworks.

1956

This year was special to the Society as they took pride in the dedication of their new building. Commemorative wall china plates depicting the statue of "Our Lady" and St. Joseph's Church went on sale for this weekly celebration. Ross Manning shows played for the week's activities.

1957-1960

Fr. Pat Schmizzi officiated to what proved to be the largest celebration in years. Three bands joined the procession and the carnival was sponsored by the Holy Name Society.

1965

The 90th year of our celebration drew throngs of people as it continued to grow in leaps and bounds. Amusements of America, one of the largest and best carnivals in the country played here for the week's entertainment.

1966-1975

The last ten years have been fruitful to our town and to the Society as we have witnessed a steady growth in our celebration. It has been here 100 years and we will devotedly try to keep it growing. To Fr. Joseph Mungari, whose dedication, desire and drive have been so instrumental in our growth, we give our special thanks. To you, the faithful of "Our Lady of Mt. Carmel," we welcome you to join us each and every year to honor and pray with Her. May She shower all Her blessings on you and yours.
