ONLINE – Theorical courses – 6 ECTS - COMPULSORY

OBJECTIVES: development of collaboration skills through the preparation of a scientific paper.

The students (divided in groups of 3-4 peoples) will have to prepare a scientific paper on one of the subjects that will be assigned after the Isernia's course. The paper (max 15,000 characters, spaces included, except bibliography and figures) will be presented on May 4th during an online meeting.









EVALUATION: students will be evaluated on the scientific quality of the paper and on the oral presentation (all member of the groups must present). The whole presentation must be of 15 min maximum.
