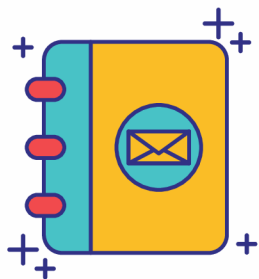
The Immanuel Directory is now ready for publication!
