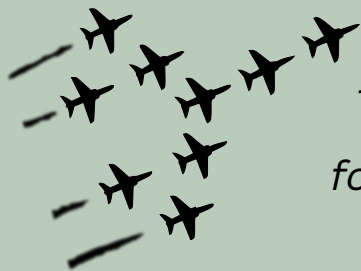

VBS Volunteers Needed July 27-30

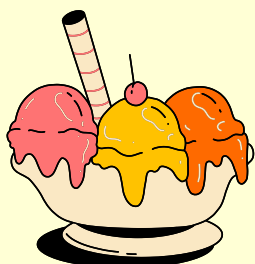


*"Don't be afraid,"
