Gratitude in the Midst of Challenges - 2

Diagnosed with Alzheimer's in 2018, the disease kept a steady downward progression changing every facet of our lives. After three years of being his carepartner (still during Covid), my husband Stephen was no longer able to safely live in our home, so we had to move him to a care facility. He kept asking to go home, which was not medically feasible. I did not have an honest, yet comforting, reply, which tore me apart. Praying for some wisdom, God finally did give me a response to his need, "Honey, it is not perfect; it's not everything, but isn't home when we're together?" Stephen mulled it over, then agreed our being together brought us "home." I would have to repeat God's words to him, and to myself, in order to keep the main thing the main thing: we were grateful to be home together no matter where we were.
