EMBALMING (\$400.00)

Embalming is the process of replacing bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is
a process of sanitation, restauration and temporary preservation. It is not legally
required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of
death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our Funeral Directors will
make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected services
needed.
