

How to prepare for your flea treatment:

TREATMENT:

1. All interior floors are treated inside.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. You need to plan on being out of the house for 2-3 hours.
- 2. All pets and birds should be removed from the premises for 2-3 hours.
- 3. Fish tanks should be covered with a towel and circulator turned off or unplugged.
- 4. If you are planning on shampooing carpets, do it before we treat.

HOW TO PREPARE:

- 1. Have all articles (such as toys, shoes, clothing, etc.) up off the floor, nothing should be under beds. Furniture is OK. The technician can reach under it.
- 2. You should vacuum BEFORE the technician comes. Either put a flea collar in the vacuum bag or make sure you throw the vacuum bag in the garbage outside because the pupa will hatch out in the vacuum bag. Nothing will kill the fleas in the egg stage. They have to hatch out and come in contact with the residue. This takes 14 days to 21 days.
- 3. Vacuum every day for 14 days AFTER the spraying. If possible, do not wash vinyl, tile or hardwood floors for 14 days.
- 4. Wash animal bedding.
- 5. We will treat cushions on the couches and chairs but not the beds. Launder all bedding in hot water. This will kill any fleas or eggs.
- 6. Have animals treated for fleas.

CONTROL:

- 1. You may see fleas for approximately 14-21 days after the spraying has been done. This is normal.
- 2. Remember to vacuum daily
