

# 2025 LEGISLATIVE YEAR IN REVIEW

## Legislative Hearings & Testimony

The Bronx Chamber of Commerce testified at **nine** hearings and public forums including before the **Committees on Contracts, Small Business**, and **Women and Gender Equity**.

## Legislative Meetings

To strengthen our presence in City government, we engaged key Bronx elected officials to advance our legislative priorities, secure funding, and build partnerships that support the businesses we serve.

## Legislative Wins

### ADVANCED

#### Fine Transparency Bill (Intro 1132)

Requires SBS to collect and publish information on fines issued to small businesses, letting businesses track which types of violations are most common, where they occur, and which industries are most affected. This will give New York City clear, accessible data to help identify patterns and make sure enforcement is fair and transparent.

#### REAP (S8063A / A8676)

Provides for relocation and employment assistance credits in cities with a population of one million or more.

#### Intro 1133 & Intro 1135

Extend existing protections for third-party delivery workers to grocery delivery workers.

### BLOCKED

#### Salary Transparency (Intro 0808)

Coordinated closely with the other Chambers to push for critical amendments, ultimately resulting in the legislation not moving forward.

### AMENDED

#### Street Vending Reform (Intro 0431)

After coordinating meetings and discussions with key stakeholders, Council Member Sanchez is considering the following amendments:

- Removal of language that would have permanently lifted the cap on vending licenses
- Increased enforcement personnel sufficient to cover at least 80% of licensees
- Targeted enforcement on restricted streets and highly congested corridors
- Mandatory suspension and license revocation for repeat offenders






